EVENT REGULATIONS

Art. 1

Organisation

The European Championships will be organized on the 24-25-26 July, with 27 July as a reserve date in case of bad weather conditions.

Art. 2

Participation

The participation is open for European Elite riders (men & Women).

NATIONAL TEAMS – derny & stayer

National Federations may enter the following riders per Championship **free of charge**:

DERNY - Women Elite – max. 2 riders (+ 2 reserve)

DERNY - Men Elite – max. 2 riders (+ 2 reserve)

STAYER – max. 3 riders (+ 2 reserve)

These riders have to compete with their National jersey.

The National Federations have to register their riders / staff / NF Official Delegates directly on the UEC website (www.uec.ch).

Deadline for the registration: **15 July 2019 (24:00 CET)**

OTHER RIDERS – derny men & women

The participation is open for European riders only.

Registration of the riders directly on the UEC website (www.uec.ch).

Registration fee: € 45,00 (late entry; € 90,00)

The registration fees for all riders must be paid in full to the UEC bank account before the deadline set for the event.

Art. 3

Regulations

The 2019 UEC Track Deryn & Stayer European Championships will be run under the auspices and according to the regulations, decisions, conditions and instructions of the UEC and UCI.

Art. 4

Control/registration participants.

The control of the licenses, clothing, registration of the participants and distribution of other documents shall be on the 24-25-26 July at the race permanence from 10:00 to 11:00.

Art. 5

Team managers meeting

Team managers' meetings, with the presence of the PCP and the UEC representative are scheduled on the 24-25-26 July at the race permanence from 11:00 to 11:30.

Art. 6

Ceremony

We kindly ask all the winners to be in time for the victory ceremony. Riders and pacers must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey (deryn & stayer riders) or team jersey (deryn riders) and shall not wear a helmet, a cap, a headband or glasses until they leave the podium ceremony area.

Art. 7

Anti-doping control

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

The anti-doping controls will be under the responsibility of the Cycling Anti-Doping Foundation (CADF).

Art. 8

Program

The program and schedule can be changed on demand of the commissaires panel and the organization under the control of the UEC.

Art. 9

Unforeseen

In those events in which the regulations do not supply, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the organization, will decide.

Art. 10

Press

Photographers are allowed on the track only with the UEC media vests. Other members of the press (photographers and journalists) are allowed on the track but only in the infield zone of the track.

In order to access the UEC Press Area an accreditation is necessary. To apply for media accreditation, please visit the UEC website www.uec.ch

Media accreditation and photographer's bib's can be collected during the opening hours of the accreditation center or at the media permanence.

Please ensure that you collect your accreditation as soon as you arrive at the velodrome as it will be required for access to all parts of the venue. Accreditations must be worn and visible whenever you pass through accreditation controls.

Art. 11

Accreditation and body numbers

The accreditations for officials, riders and staff will be available at the permanence during the opening time. Body numbers will be distributed at the technical meeting. The accreditation shall be issued in accordance with the lists sent by the UEC and the National Federations.

Art. 12

Penalties

The UCI scale of penalties will solely apply.

Art. 13

Stayer:

Motors (Engines) / Pacemachines are provided by the organizer.

Gear limitations max. 9,40 m (66 x 15).

In accordance with the UCI rules, article 1.3.018

"In track competition, including motor-pacing, the use of a front disc wheel is only permitted in the specialities against the clock."

Derny:

Motors (Engines) & Pacers **are not** provided by the organizer.

It is necessary to bring and use your own Derny machine.

The gear ratio will not be limited.

Art. 14

Pacemakers suits

Pacemakers suits will be provided by the organizer in accordance with UCI Rules.
