Women: numbers 401 – 425 for handlebars

with purple color bar at the bottom of the number plates. Back numbers

Identification for athletes and helpers by bracelet (with different colors for the categories). Entering sections is allowed for bracelet owners only.

The National Federations have to register their riders directly on the UEC website (www.uec.ch).

<u>Deadline for the registrations</u> (riders, staff and NF Official Delegates):

24 September 2019 (23:59 CET)

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

ARTICLE 4. AWARDS CEREMONIES

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony.

Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing.

Riders must present themselves at the podium.
