

2020 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP Teams Ranking Competition Guide & Rules

General:

The 2020 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist of 10 rounds. All rounds count.

Rounds 1 & 2: Verona (ITA) Rounds 3 & 4: Zolder (BEL) Rounds 5 & 6: Papendal (NOR) Rounds 7 & 8: Sarrians (FRA) Rounds 9 & 10: Råde (NOR)

All teams have to register through UEC, deadline 1st March 2020, in order to take part in the 2020 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition. The registration form is published on the website www.uec.ch.

The overall award ceremony will be held at the European Championships in Dessel (BEL) with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX Commission will award Prizemoney to the 3 first teams at the end of 10 rounds:

Rules :

- Teams wanting to participate in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition must register a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders, aged 13 years and over.
- o National Championship teams will also be allowed to participate in the team ranking.
- Each team pays a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline 1th March 2020) – UEC fee € 500,-.
- UEC teams have to confirm their 4 rider participation before each event at team registration, according to the time schedule. Teams have to fill-in the Team Entry form before each event at Team Confirmation on Friday.
- Riders from all classes are welcome to enter the regular UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition: Challenge (20 & 24') and Championship.
- $\circ~$ Minimum age for team riders to register is 13 years and over.
- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach at the event.





- A team manager can enter a team for the 1st day of the Competition, and a different team for the 2nd day of the competition. This can only be done on Friday at team confirmation.
- If a rider is not able to race or not racing at all on day 2, the team manager can enter a new rider for the 2nd day of competition. This must be done before the start of the block 1 motos on Day 2.
- Points will be given according to the UEC Points table (see end of this document).
- When classes are combined because it doesn't meet the minimum number of riders, only the results of the final are split per class.
 This means a rider receives points for finished position during moto's and qualifying rounds. The results of the motos and qualifying rounds will not be split.
 After the result of the Final, each rider receives points for final position after split result.
 The split result is also used for the podium ceremony.
- UEC Teams only receive team passes for an event when they enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- o A Team manager must provide a photo for the UEC accreditation at registration of the Team.
- A team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.
- Each registered UEC Team receives 1 pass for the team manager at the 1st event of the season when they enter their team for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition. This pass is valid during the 10 Rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup. This pass is not valid during the UEC BMX European Championships. The pass cannot be replaced during the season.
- $\circ~$ UEC Team manager pass has the following rights:
 - o Free entry to track
 - o Entry to staging
 - Entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
 - o Entry to Team manager meeting
 - Entry to Team manager area
- UEC Teams that do not enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as any other team without UEC registration.
- A team tent space will not automatically be assigned to a UEC Team. A UEC team also has to register for the team tent space with the organiser of a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- A UEC registered team can rent a team tent space at the event of 6 x 3 m, at the cost of a maximum of € 150,00. This includes 1x free event entry ticket per team tent space paid for.





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Other teams

The Organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of a minimum of \in 200,00. These teams receive 1x free event entry ticket.

Team area

UEC asks organisers to make a placement plan for the team area, to make it easy for riders to go to staging from the team area and from the finish line back to the team area.

Please keep the following order into account when making a team area plan: 1st priority and less close to staging: National Championship teams 2nd priority and closest to staging: UEC registered teams 3rd priority and farthest from staging: all other teams that rented a team tent space
