Bracelets





- Riders receive black bracelets for entrance to the track
- People with accreditation receive an orange bracelet
- Staff have red bracelets
- Saturday entry = yellow / Sunday entry = bleu

Rider Information



- All riders receive black bracelet for entrance to the track
- The transponders for Championship riders will be handed out to each Chef d'Equipe after TM meeting.
- Transponders from 1 country are all in 1 bag, including a list of riders and transponder numbers.
- The Chef d'Equipe return all transponders together in the bag received after racing at the Finish line. This can be Saturday after the race or Sunday after Team Time Trial.
- If a rider fails to return a transponder an invoice of 100 euro will be send to the federation.
- The transponders of cancelled riders are in the bag, please leave them all in the bag and return everything as soon as possible after the race.
- It is the rider's own responsibility to ride with the correct transponder, riding with the wrong transponder can result in DNS

National team Information



- UEC collects personal information from coaches for event related information only
- This information will only be used during the 2021 UEC BMX European Championships to inform coaches and Team Managers of changes or meetings
- After the event this data will be deleted according to the EU General Data
 Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- The organiser needs to provide Insurance Information from the federation to the hospital. Please provide this information to the organiser
 Please make sure your riders have insurance information when they go to hospital

Team Manager Information



- Team Manager area during racing : area after finish line or in the grandstands
- Team manager area during Championship training
 - Between 5 m hill and 2nd turn
 - After gate start: next to 5m hill
- Video analysts can be in both grandstands
- Accreditation and bracelets for team managers will grant access to all grandstands

BMX Team Time Trial



- UEC organises a BMX time trial event Official title
- Race on Sunday 11 July between moto's and 1/8 finals
- A BMX Time trial is a race against the clock with teams of riders of the same nationality and same gender.
- A team of riders consists of 3 men, or 3 women
- Categories are Men aged 17 and over;
 Women aged 17 and over
- In a BMX Team Time Trial event riders of a team will start at the same time. The finishing time shall be taken on the 3rd rider crossing the finishing line

Equipment



- All Championships riders must compete in their national team jersey, except for World Champions
- No National Champion Jersey or sleeve allowed
- Shorts are allowed, but the shins and knees must be covered with protection to just above the ankle
- On board cameras are forbidden during competition. Allowed during practice; only if mounted on bike or helmet visor
- Not allowed on the track without the right equipment

Race procedures – Rules reminders



- For Championships classes World Cup race system is used
- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically www.uec.ch – event page www.facebook.com/bmxrace.results or
 - Twitter account @JSTiming
- Countries will receive Country moto sheets, collect them from the copy office on the finish line
- Front and side plates provided by the organiser must be used by riders

Race procedures – Rules reminders



- Properly functioning riders' equipment including bicycles, clothing and safety equipment is the responsibility of the riders, TM, or parents
- If a problem with equipment is noticed in staging the rider will be sent away till the problem is fixed. The rider's heat will be put back 10 heats if the rider does not return before their start. We will not wait longer than 10 heats.
- If the problem is noticed when the rider is on the top of the start hill:
 - During practice: rider can receive an official warning and cannot be allowed back until problem is fixed
 - During racing: if a problem is identified when the rider is on the track he will receive a DNF
- It is each rider's responsibility to be in the staging area and on the gate in the correct gate position at the appropriate times

Weather conditions



- PCP, Technical Delegate and Organiser will monitor the weather conditions and if necessary decide on the present level of risk based on observations and consultation with riders
- If weather conditions are unacceptable, the above mentioned people have the authority to immediately suspend activity on the track
- Weather predication for tomorrow at this moment is light rain, with this predications we will proceed with the published schedule.
- Team Managers will always be informed of any changes using the contact information

Medical center



Medics are situated under the 8m hill

If one of your riders does not plan to start, please inform JS
 Timing as soon as possible, whether for medical reasons or other reasons

Finals Championship



- We race all 6 Championship finals first
- Top 3 riders need to stay inside the staging area to prepare for the ceremony
- Winners will be asked to do an interview Prepare your riders for this interviews in English
- Then we go straight to the podium for the ceremony

Award ceremony Championship



- Top 3 on the podium
 - The 1st place: UEC Champions jersey and Gold medal
 - The 2nd place: Silver medal
 - The 3rd place: Bronze medal
- Riders must present themselves at the podium within 10 minutes after crossing the finish line
- Riders must appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing. The wearing of caps, hats, helmets, headbands, goggles, sunglasses and all branded material is not allowed.
- After the official UEC photo the riders can have an opportunity to take a photo for their social media
