

### **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- Testing is mandatory for Championships riders, national federation & UEC team staff, media, UEC staff including commissaires, anti-doping, timing, and implementation.
  - A negative Covid test result must be provided prior to the first entry to the event venue showing a negative result and having been taken within 72 hours.
  - Test results are valid for 72 hours and a new test must be completed (PCR or Antigen) to maintain access to the event venue.
  - Negative COVID test certificates must be taken to Rider confirmation for each team member
  - Staff will be stationed at the entrance to the event venue to check test results comply with this requirement.
- Face masks/face coverings are to be worn at all times, with the exception of riders on track and in warmup (training and race). Any person at the event venue who is seen without a mask for an extended period of time will have their accreditation removed.
- Regular hand washing/sanitising is expected. Hand sanitiser will be provided at multiple locations on the event area.
- Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times.
- We recommend the use of a COVID clinical suspicion questionnaire, to be completed daily on the 5 days preceding the event.

### **COVID-19 TESTS – ON SITE**

- Tests will be available at the entrance to the event venue on Friday/Saturday and Sunday
- The cost of €25/€30 for an Antigen test, with results available within 15/20 mins.

- Bubbles are a group who can mix together but who cannot mix with another bubble. They are identified as follows:
  - o <u>Team</u>
    - All Riders
    - National Federation staff
    - We recommend each team to form their own bubble
  - Media
    - Photography personnel
    - Written media
    - Social media

- UEC will also separate into smaller functional bubbles.

TV will also separate into smaller functional bubbles.

Bubbles must keep separated wherever possible and any interaction must respect social distancing and use of masks.

The priority at all times is given to the Team bubble.





## RIDERS' CONFIRMATION AT WELCOME CENTER

- Limited number of people in the room at the same time.
- Only one nation/registered team to be in the room at any time.
- Only one person per nation/registered team is allowed to complete;
  - Self-declarations for nation
  - Payment of Entry fees

- o Plate numbers distributed together with the transponders
- Accreditation for Team Staff and riders

## **VENUE ORGANIZATION**

The venue will be divided into three areas (see ANNEX 1 – Venue map). The passage between areas is not allowed, with the exception of the passage of athletes

- GREEN ZONE (track and starting grid) athletes, competition judges, medical staff and track staff members restricted access.
  - Inside this area it is mandatory wearing a face mask (KN95 is suitable) except the riders involved in competition
- YELLOW ZONE (team tents) athletes and team staff only restricted access.
  - In this zone a fenced tent area will be provided for each team (National team, ecc) in order to protect and guarantee the integrity of the protecting bubbles.

Team staff will have to manage both challenge and championship athletes as no one else can enter the yellow zone.

- Only riders and team staff are allowed in the team area.
- o No media are allowed in the team area.
- o Teams that have purchased a tent, will be provided an area in Team Area 1, roped off to maintain distance.
- o Teams without a tent, will be provided with a roped off area for their use in Team Area 2.
- o Riders should remain in the areas that are allocated for their team only.

Riders who are not directly involved in race activities must remain in the team tent, even between the motos and the different stages of the race.

It is not allowed to stay inside the yellow area after the end of the competition. Riders who finished the race have to leave the event site.

WHITE ZONE (grand stand) accompanying persons only restricted access.

Access to this area will be allowed only to 1 for each rider Only limited seating will be available.

Access to this area do not will be allowed to riders, as well as their bike.





### **EVENT OPERATIONS**

- Call up / Staging
  - Media are not allowed in call up/staging area
  - o Commissaires will remain at entrance wherever possible
- Start Ramp
  - o Riders and Commissaires only on the back of the start ramp and at the gate
- Team Managers Viewing Area
  - o The Team Manager Pass and bracelet will be required for entrance
  - Masks/face covering must be worn at all times
  - Use of the area should be limited at all times
  - Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times
- Practice and Warmup
  - Masks/face covering must be worn at all times by non-riders
  - o Commissaires will keep their distance from the teams where possible
  - Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times

#### **MEDIA**

- Under no circumstances are Media allowed to access the team area (Yellow Zone).
- Media are not allowed inside the Podium area.
- Media will have designated times on the track and within a designated area only.
- Any Media outside of the times/locations allocated could have their accreditation removed.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FEDERATIONS & TEAMS**

- Create and adhere to your own team bubble.
- Minimise contact with other bubbles wherever possible.
- All media requests you receive and any casual contact with media should be managed appropriately. (Never in the Team Areas)
- Consider any rider outside your Nation or BMX Team as a separate bubble and manage any contact appropriately.
- Expect to be asked for contact tracing information by service-providers and provide this accurately.

# **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR RIDERS**

- Avoid signing autographs and taking selfies with others outside your bubble.
- Wear a mask unless on the track
- Continue to wear a mask until at least call-up starts.
- Only agree to a media interview if the interviewer is distancing & taking appropriate hygiene measures.




