Candidature for UEC Management Board

DELMINO PEREIRA (POR)



Delmino Pereira, born in Vila Real on August 23, 1967, started his activity as an amateur cyclist in 1985, and he was professional rider from 1989 to 2001, always in Boavista Futebol Clube cycling team.

As a professional cyclist, he won two titles as National Road Race Champion, won 54 races, qualified five times in the first 10 places in "Volta a Portugal". At international level he participated in the Road World Championships / Stuttgart - 1991 (49th place) and won the best climber in the "Tour de l'Avenir" (1988).

During his career, he founded in 1995 the Portuguese Association of Professional Cyclists and was the 1st president.

After his career, he had a brief experience as a sports director in club teams.

In 2004 he joined the Management Board of the Portuguese Cycling Federation, chaired by Artur Lopes, performing functions in training, standing out for his dynamism that impressed the Portuguese MTB, department that he has been allocated in 2008 by the then President.

With the new mandate for the Olympic Cycle of 2008-2012, Delmino Pereira rose to the position of vice president of the Federation, assuming more and more responsibilities and a decisive experience for his candidacy for the presidency.

Delmino Pereira chaired the Portuguese Cycling Federation since 2012, with recognized work at national and international level, highlighting the dynamics developed in CAR - Anadia - National Velodrome. Deployed and developing all cycling Olympic disciplines from the training ages to elite, it managed through the National Teams close to 50 medals in World and European Championships in all disciplines of cycling.

In 2015, UCI Congress awarded the Federation with the distinction of UCI Merit. In 2017 he was appointed by the President of the UCI to the UCI Road Commission.

At this moment, he is in the third term as president of the Portuguese Cycling Federation.
