In cooperation with the UEC General Secretary Enrico della Casa and technical delegate Vladimiro Petsas we have managed to transform the cycling competitions in the 2<sup>nd</sup> European Games 2019 in Minsk in a bright and wonderful holiday for thousands of supporters.

Looking back, I am really proud to be part of these events that left a mark on cycling history and contributed to establish the UEC as a respected sports federation focused on the future.

Our new challenge is the first ever Super Cycling European Championships that we planned to organize together with the UEC in 2021.
