During my presidential tenure, my team and I have executed significant financial restructuring of the SCF, which back in 2012 when I took the presidency over from my predecessor, was significantly financial distress. With a true team effort and determination, we have managed to successfully complete the turnaround and we are now producing positive operating and bottom-line results for the 4th year running. The financial position of our SCF is now sustainable and long term viable, which sets a robust foundation for future integral support of cycling development in Slovenia.

With my team, we have managed to raise some significant funding for the SCF in order to further strengthen the longer-term financial viability of our federation and promotion of sport in the country and broader.
