Some Information about COVID-19, Travel, Certificate, ... for Participants/Competitors/Officials

Please take notice and observe the following instructions and information:

If you suspect you could be infected with the Covid-19 virus or you have symptoms which could indicate an infection:

Stay at home; do not endanger others. Do not come to the club, course, or any premises at the event and avoid all contact to others.

At the Sports Venue

1. Separate yourself and keep your distance to others.

General Information

We have done everything in our power in accordance with the official regulations to ensure a “safe environment” to hold this event for you.

Please support our measures personally by strictly complying with all our rules and regulations. The general hygiene rules must be observed at all times, especially as follows:

- Minimum distance of 1,5 meters at all times outdoors and indoors.
- Masks must be worn indoors.
- Wash your hands regularly with soap or disinfectant
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or handkerchief
- Do not shake hands, high five or hug anyone and avoid unnecessary bodily contact
- Avoid touching your face
- Use the disinfectant provided on entering the event and during it.
- However, you should also bring your own disinfectant and use it continuously.
- Everyone must bring their own mask and have it ready for use at all times without being asked to do so.

How long is the COVID certificate valid?

The validity period varies according to whether your COVID certificate documents a vaccination, recovery from COVID-19 or a negative test. The validity may be adjusted on the basis of new scientific data.

Important: The following information is valid in Switzerland. Other countries may specify different periods of validity.

For people who have been vaccinated

- 365 days from when the last vaccine dose was administered

For people who have recovered from COVID

- The certificate is valid from the 11th day after the positive test result and lasts for 180 days from the date of the test result.

For people who have tested negative

- PCR test: 72 hours from when the sample was taken
- Rapid antigen test: 48 hours from when the sample was taken

The Covid-19 Information form on page 3 has to be read and signed by every single participant, competitor or official which is registered by name through their national federation. Without the form it's not allowed to enter the venue.

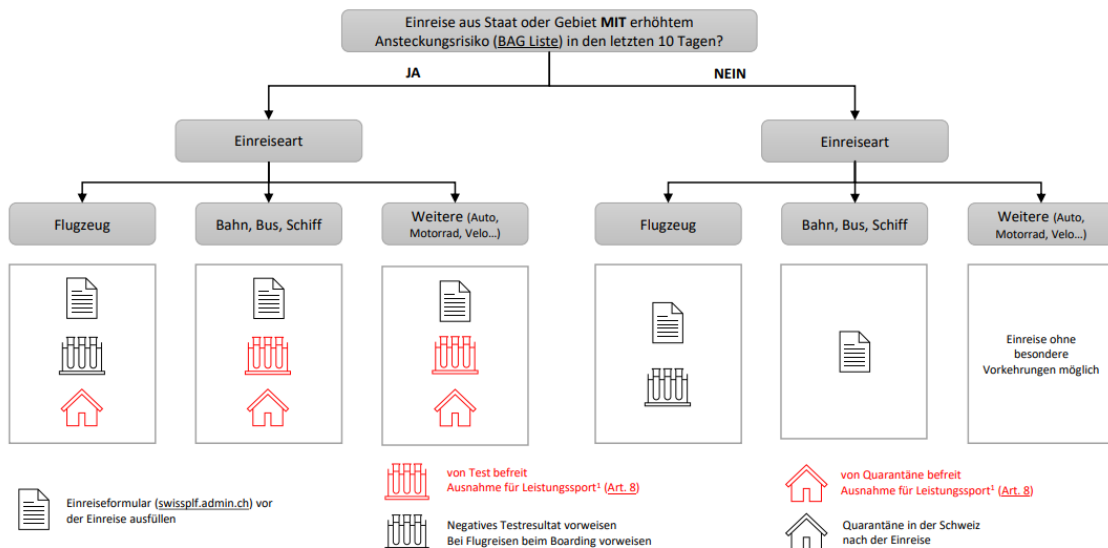

Wer einen Schweizer Pass hat oder über eine gültige Aufenthaltsbewilligung in der Schweiz verfügt, darf aus jedem Land in die Schweiz einreisen. Für alle anderen Personen können Einreise-beschränkungen bestehen. - Falls ich einreisen darf – Welche Regeln habe ich als Leistungssportler*in zu beachten?**
Leistungssportler*innen¹: Sind im Besitz einer Swiss Olympic Card (Gold, Silber, Bronze, Elite) oder Swiss Olympic Talent Card (National, Regional) und/oder sind Angehörige eines nationalen Kaders (die Zugehörigkeit zu einem nationalen Kader legt der jeweilige Sportverband fest). Soweit in einem Sportverband keine Swiss Olympic Cards vergeben werden oder abschliessende Kader definiert sind, sind mit Leistungssportler*innen diejenigen Personen gemeint, die vom betreffenden nationalen Verband regelmässig für die Teilnahme an internationalen Wettkämpfen in ihrer Sportart und Kategorie selektioniert werden.

COVID-19 Information

for Participants/Competitors/Officials

Before entering the venue, all persons must confirm:

1. That they feel fit and healthy enough to participate in the intended sport and if they are in any doubt, they will consult a doctor beforehand.

2. That they are not knowingly infected with the Covid-19 virus nor were they knowingly in contact with an infected person.

3. That they have a valid proof, with a certificate, that they're vaccinated, negative tested or recovered.

4. They have not stayed in a high risk Covid-19 area within the last 14 days.

5. They themselves have not been in contact with a Covid-19 infected person (based on the current valid regulations) or anyone in home quarantine.

Furthermore, when entering the venue all visitors and participants must expressly agree that:

a. He/she provide their personal data, namely name, date of birth, address, telephone number, e-mail data on their health status or emergency contact data in the event of a Covid-19 infection or suspected infection to facilitate health officials tracing contacts; by the organizer or third parties commissioned by the organizers.

Reference in this regard is made to the corresponding data protection declaration (available at the venue or on their home page).

b. The organizer can carry out attendance checks and use video surveillance. In this regard, reference is made to the corresponding data protection declaration of the organizer (available on their homepage)

c. He/she will follow the instructions of the event organizer or his authorized third parties, otherwise they may be subject to reprimand or exclusion.

d. parents or persons in charge of supervision are responsible for their children or persons under supervision and are liable for them or with them (then jointly and severally)

e. at the request of the organizer of the event or his / her authorized third party, he / she will also confirm the knowledge of and compliance with these rules of conduct with his / her signature.

I hereby confirm that I am fully aware of the "COVID-19 INFORMATION for Participants/Competitors/Officials" and that none of the risks listed under points 1. to 4. apply to me, or those under point a. up to point e. and I agree to follow these instructions.
