Start/Finish

Start order

Qualifications by drawing lots

Finals based on the results

Start

The start is signalled by a whistle AND a flag.

Finish

After finishing the race, the riders must leave immediately the course at the right side.

Allocation of boxes

For each category the pit boxes are not allocated and are free to use according to own discretion of mechanics.

Feeding and litter zone

- The act of handing out food or drinks is not allowed.
- Nevertheless, a rider may keep and use food or drinks which they carry on their bikes or in their outfits.
- Throw away of bottles or trash is only allowed in the litter zone. The riders
 undertake to respect nature and the environment throughout the course and not
 to pollute the site.
- The littering zone will be the pit area along its entire length. Waste must be deposited on the side of the course. It is strictly forbidden to throw waste directly onto the course or outside the designated area.

Important points.

- For the cyclo-cross bicycle the width of the tyres (measured between the widest parts) shall not exceed 33 mm and it may not incorporate any form of spike or stud.
- Using of disc brakes are allowed in cyclo-cross training and competition.
- Personal high-pressure cleaners are forbidden in the pit area during the championships.

Access Start/Finish-Pit Area

Each rider may be accompanied by a paramedical assistant and two mechanics.

The paramedical assistant and the mechanics must be provided by the organizer with a bracelet, which gives them access to the start / finish zone or the pit area.

The bracelets must be worn by the people confirmed. These bracelets give access to the course without accreditation.

Bib numbers

- The use of number pockets (whatever the material) is not allowed. Arm or back identification number must be placed on the outer layer of clothing.
- Arm number, in order to be visible from the front.
