Auditors' Report on the 2018 UEC Accounts

To: the General Assembly of the UEC

We conducted an audit to verify the 2018 accounts of the UEC as required under article 16.2 of the UEC's statutes. These accounts consist of Income and Expenditure Account for the twelve months to 31st December 2018 and the Balance Sheet as at 31st December 2018, as detailed in the 2018 report. The audit involved:


- Verification of a sample of transactions and balances to supporting documentation;
- Confirmation of the published Income and Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet to the accounting system, and;
- Making general enquiries regarding the 2018 accounts.

Auditor's report

12. Modifications of the UEC Constitution

STRENGTHEN THE POSITION OF WOMEN IN GOVERNANCE – UCI Agenda 2022

It has not escaped our attention that women are grossly underrepresented in the governance of our sport, whether it be at the UCI, the Continental Confederations or the National Federations. In taking the same approach as the IOC in this matter, we must be proactive. We will also implement an action plan.

- *Set up a programme designed to nurture talented women and promote their access to positions of responsibility (2019-2022).*
- **Amend the UCI Statutes to guarantee the presence of two women among the seven European members of the UCI Management Committee (2019).**
- **Ensure female representation of at least 25% per continent among the 45 voting delegates at the UCI Congress (2019).**
- **Amend the statutes of the Continental Confederations to ensure that women account for at least 25% of the members of their Management Committees (2019).**
- *Amend the UCI Statutes to include the obligation on the part of the National Federations to ensure female representation on their executive committees (2019).*
- *Aim to make 25% of commissaires women (2018-2022).*

MODIFICATIONS OF THE UEC CONSTITUTION

Article 2

Identity, Purpose

1. UEC identity:

- a) The UEC is the European continental confederation for national cycling federations in accordance with article 23 and subsequent articles of the UCI Constitution.
- b) The UEC seeks to preserve the unity of world cycling, to promote the interests of European cycling in all disciplines, **including virtual/electronic cycling activities and competition under all forms**, and to represent the interests of European cycling federations.

Note: modification of the UCI Constitution approved on the 28th September 2018

2. Purpose:

The UEC's purpose, subject to UCI's prerogatives, is:

- i) to promote the role of women in the governance of cycling;**

12. Modifications Statuts UEC

Article 9

Duties of the General Assembly

1. The General Assembly shall have the following exclusive powers and duties:

- e) To ~~appoint~~ **elect** European candidates for the UCI Management Committee (art. 47, 48, 51 and 52 of the UCI Constitution),

Note: modification of the UCI Constitution approved on the 28th September 2018

Article 10

The Management Committee is composed of :

4. In the event of any vacancies, the Management Committee will remain validly constituted and the vacant posts shall be filled at the next General Assembly, **respecting the minimum representation of women referred to article 13.7-(a)**. When the post of President is vacant, the measures of article 12.6 and 12.7 shall apply. When the total number of vacancies is more than 3, an electoral General Assembly must be convened immediately.

Article 13

Elections

6. Provided that there are at least as many candidates as there are vacancies to be filled, Every voting member must vote for as many candidates as there are vacancies. Any other vote is null and void.

7. All elections are held with a majority vote in one round. Within the limits of the number of vacancies to be filled, applicants with the highest number of votes cast will be elected, provided that:

- a) concerning the election of the Management Committee members, at least two (2) women are elected, taking into account the gender of the elected President. To this end, two posts (or one post if the elected President is a woman) are allocated as a priority to the two women (or the woman) having received the highest number of votes validly cast. Other women may be declared elected to other posts;**
- b) concerning the election of the delegates of the UEC members for the UCI Congress, at least 25% of the elected incumbents are shall be women. To this end, 25% of posts are allocated as a priority to the women who have received the highest number of votes validly cast. Other women may be declared elected to other posts.**

8. In the event of a tie, the oldest candidate shall be elected.



12. Modifications Statuts UEC

9. In the event that it is impossible to assure the minimum representation of women referred to in paragraph 7 on account of an insufficient number of candidates, the posts concerned will remain vacant until the following General Assembly, when they will be filled.

Article 14

UEC member delegates for the UCI Congress

5. In the event of the temporary absence of one of the UEC member delegates at the UCI Congress, his/her deputy shall be appointed from the list of deputies, **provided that at least 25% of the total number of delegates will still be women**, by the Management Committee or, in an emergency, by the President.

6. In the event of permanent incapacity of a UEC delegate member to the UCI Congress for whatever reason, he/she shall be replaced by a deputy in order of their presentation **provided that at least 25% of the total number of delegates will still be women.**

Article 15

~~Appointment~~ **Election** of European candidates for the UCI Management Committee

1. Pursuant to article 51 of the UCI Constitution, candidates from a UEC member country for the UCI Management Committee shall be proposed to the UCI Congress by the UEC. For the appointment of UEC candidates the electoral rules stipulated in article 3 of the present Constitution are applicable *mutatis mutandis*.
2. **The list of elected candidates must include at least two (2) women. In the event that it is impossible to assure this minimum representation of women on account of an insufficient number of candidates, the posts concerned will remain vacant until the following General Assembly, at the occasion of which they will be filled, provided that the UCI constitution so permits.**

Article 27

Applicable law – Effective from

1. The UEC is governed by Swiss Law. In the event of the UEC Constitution does not stipulating specific rules, the measures contained in the UCI Constitution shall be directly applicable in a suppletive capacity,
2. This Constitution is effective from 13 March 2016. **It has been modified on 10 March 2019.**
