



UEC - European Road Cycling Championships 'TRENTINO 2021'



HEALTH PLAN

INTRODUCTION

The UEC - European Road Cycling Championships will take place from 8 to 12 September 2021 in Trento - Monte Bondone - Valle dell'Adige - Valle dei Laghi.

Events: Individual Time Trial, Road Race.

Participants expected in the five competition days: ca. 1200.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Medical assistance will be provided by doctors (most of them Anaesthesia, Critical and Intensive Care specialists), nurses (most of them coming from critical area, territorial emergency and urgent care departments), ambulances and an advanced medical post, with variable distribution depending on the competition days (see Programme).

The Trentino Italian Red Cross will be present at the event, in cooperation with the law enforcement and fire departments. Collaboration with other voluntary associations of the Autonomous Province of Trento is possible.

The ambulances used for medical assistance comply with the minimum equipment required for BLS vehicles as per Trentino Emergenza guidelines.

ACTIVATION AND MANAGEMENT OF HEALTH INTERVENTIONS

At the beginning of the event, the Health coordination unit will inform the COP (Provincial Operations Centre) “Trentino Emergenza” of the start of the event coverage, confirming all radio equipment and available ambulances.

Anyone who witnesses and/or comes across a traumatic and/or medical event on the race track shall immediately notify the Health coordination unit by radio or wired communication (specifying area of the event, kilometre of the race and number of injured people).

On receipt of the alert, the Health coordination unit and/or the Medical Director shall send all resources necessary for the healthcare management of the event, if not already present.

The medical personnel, with the support of the rescuers if necessary, will treat the patient according to the approved protocols. The PPE to be worn during assistance (as specified in the established COVID PLAN) includes: FFP2 mask, mask/goggles, gloves. A suit/gown shall also be worn if a person shows Covid-related symptoms. Subsequently, the doctor will decide whether to hospitalize the patient with the most suitable means and choose the medical assistance necessary for transport. The Health coordination unit and/or Medical Director will be the first to alert the COP 118, unless otherwise demanded by the doctor and/or nurse on site. All subsequent communications will be handled by the on-site healthcare team and the COP Trentino Emergenza. In case of intervention/hospitalization, the healthcare teams and ambulances will communicate the return to operation in a timely manner. Before returning to the race, the ambulance and the devices used at the Italian Red Cross headquarters in via Muredei in Trento will have to be sanitized (total time of sanitation for returning to operation: 15').

The Advanced Medical Post (AMP) will be divided into 3 sections: the first reserved to athletes and Covid-free certified personnel, the second reserved to the public, the third for people with symptoms attributable to SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19).

All interventions must be recorded on the Trentino Emergenza summary forms and delivered to the Health coordination unit at the end of the race (please indicate the athlete's race number and personal data as per riders' list).

Please pay the utmost attention during the competition phases. Do not use acoustic/light devices unless authorized by the Health coordination unit and/or the Medical Director and/or the COP Trentino Emergenza.

In the event of an emergency that cannot be controlled through the available resources, the Trentino Emergenza - 118 units or other necessary units will be mobilised according to the normal activation protocols.
