The House of H. C. Andersen Hans Christian Andersen is the one of the most famous and best-read authors in the world, universally renowned for his wonderful fairy tales. Now his stories become the cornerstone of an innovative museum. The first of its kind in the world, the new H.C. Andersen House tells us not about the life and times of Hans Christian Andersen, the author. It describes our time. The exhibition is all about you and me. H.C. Andersen's House is not about Hans Christian Andersen – but it speaks as he speaks to us. Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tales are just as vibrant and relevant today as they were in the 1800s when he wrote them. Link about: https://hcandersenshus.dk/en/						
Thorvald Ellegaards Arena - the Velodrome Thorvald Ellegaard Arena is a covered cycle track with athletics facilities in the middle. The arena is named after Thorvald Ellegaard. In his day, he was a living legend - and perhaps the greatest cyclist Denmark has ever fostered. He was active for no less than 31 years. In addition to the six World Championships (1901-1911), it turned into three European Championships, 24 Danish Championships and 11 victories in the Copenhagen Grand Prix. He won 925 races on 153 bike lanes around the world.						
Odense Cycle track originally opened on 25 July 1948 as an outdoor track in the open air and then became the home track for the track department of the local cycling club Cycling Odense. The course hosted the Junior World Championships in 1988. In 2013, the course was broken down to build a new covered course. In a public-private partnership, a new covered cycle track with athletics facilities was to be built instead.						
During the visit, we meet volunteer trainers and enthusiasts who annually gather 7000 school-children on the bike path and introduce it to track cycling. We will also hear about the Dream of Gold. And how a small nation like Denmark works focused on competing with the big cycling nations in Europe and the world. In other words, you will at this visit meet cycling, for sport, for fun and for a better life – in real-life.
