Any teams, broadcasters, press and any other individuals planning to use radio equipment in the United Kingdom must apply for a radio license which will be issued by Ofcom (the regulator of communication services in the United Kingdom).

Due to space limitations at both the remote start areas in Edinburgh and Loch Lomond, and at the start/finish area in Glasgow, a maximum of three vehicle passes will be provided to each National Federation to access these team parking areas. Any

National Federations utilising a 'Team Bus' as one of those three vehicles will not be allocated a Team Box in any team parking area.
