1. INTRODUCTION


The Portuguese Cycling Federation and the city of Anadia are proud to welcome you for the 2023 UEC BMX European Cup, rounds 11 & 12, at the BMX track of High Performance Centre Anadia, home of the Portuguese National Cycling Teams.

2. TRACK DETAILS

The track is approximately 420metres long, with both an 8 metres SX start hill for Championship classes and 5 metres start hill for Challenge classes. The layout consists of four straight lines including three duplicated and three high asphalt corners.



3. THE CITY OF ANADIA



Anadia, a "Land of Passions" among vineyards and wines

Located between the flat countryside and the mountain tops, Anadia is a genuine and dazzling municipality, with a lot to see, taste and visit. This "Land of Passions", intensely shaped by unique vineyard landscapes, presents itself as the perfect destination for wine tourism lovers, also appreciating culture, sports, art, gastronomy, emotions, nature and thermal spas.

Places to visit

As an example, we can mention the Bairrada Wine Museum, located in Anadia city centre, which shows the wine's history, and the Aliança Underground Museum, in the village of Sangalhos, an underground museum

where sparkling wines, wines and brandies are aged in perfect communion with artistic collections. Guided tours to wineries and cellars, traditional and modern, are also part of the touristic offer in the municipality of Anadia.

Integrated in the Bairrada Distinguished Region, Anadia is a wine tourism destination of excellence, where sublime wines and sparkling wines are born, recognised nationally and internationally for their distinctiveness and quality. Among the many selling points of these products with unique characteristics, the Espaço Bairrada da Curia stands out. Located in a historical village with unique thermal waters, it occupies the building of the old railway station of Curia, a historical monument that has been reused, preserving the original architecture.

Accommodation

In Anadia, it is easy to find solutions for accommodation. The offer is varied and satisfies all sorts of preferences, from the simplest to the most refined. The tourist may choose to stay in a hotel, a boarding house, a rural house, a guest house, a hostel or even a windmill.

Gastronomy

The famous Bairrada suckling pig is the king of Anadia's gastronomy. Its cuisine also consists of chanfana, rice with brown sauce, suckling pig cabidela and, among other specialities, codfish 'à prior'. These traditional dishes combine perfectly with wines and sparkling wines from local producers. For dessert, the specialities Amores da Curia, Barriga de Freira, Fanecos and Bairradinos stand out.

By car

Driving from Porto (99 km), keep on the A1 towards Aveiro. Follow the exit 15 of the A1 to the N235 toward Aveiro/N233/Águeda. Proceed on the N235 to Rua Ivo Neves in Sangalhos.

Driving from Lisbon (229 km), keep on the A1 towards Mealhada. Follow the exit 14 toward Cantanhede/Mealhada. Follow Rua Várzea to the IC2. Follow the N235 to Rua Ivo Neves in Sangalhos.

By Train

There aren't direct trains from the airports to Sangalhos.

In the airport you need to take the metro to the train station: Porto - Campanhã or Lisboa- Oriente.



9. REGISTRATION AND RIDER'S CONFIRMATION

New registration procedure


In 2023 UEC introduced a new registration platform. Federations, registered teams, clubs, families and riders will be able to register riders for UEC BMX European Cup races.

Please find the registration platform via this link: <https://registration.jstiming.com/>

- National Federations can provide the name and e-mail addresses of their clubs, so they can register their riders directly. These clubs will receive a login for a club account.
- Individual riders can create a personal account with their UCI-ID. Anyone with UCI-ID can create a personal or a family account.
- Parents/guardians of youth riders can create a 'family account' based on a rider's UCI-ID. A maximum of 5 riders can be registered with this account.
- If assistance is needed, please contact info@jstiming.com.

Registration and payment details

- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly.
- Administration fee is € 3,50 per rider, per round, per class (including € 2 in favour of the rider's National Federation).
- Bank costs depend on your payment choice and will be charged directly.
- After registration you receive a confirmation mail from JSTiming.
Note: this email might be in your spam box.
- Cancellation costs are € 5,00 plus administration/bank costs € 1,50 per rider.
- After cancellation you receive a cancellation email from JSTiming.
- Refund will follow after the deadline for cancellations.

Late entries are possible for all riders, open from: 17-8-2023

Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

In case of a cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per round) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

Transponders

All riders in Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager. Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race.

If a rider fails to return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100.00 per transponder to the federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next UEC BMX European Cup round until the invoice is paid.

Above apply both for all races of the UEC BMX European Cup.

10. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Riders categories: as set forth in chapter 7.
- UEC BMX European Cup events are open to all riders who are licensed by a National Federation, with a minimum age of 7 years old. There is no limit in the number of riders a country can register.
- Event format Challenge categories: For all Challenge categories scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.

Event format Championship categories:

- the UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to articles 6.3.009 till 6.3.014 of the latest version of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- Riders are not automatically entered in both Rounds of each UEC BMX European Cup event. During riders confirmation on Friday, riders can opt to participate in only 1 Round during the UEC BMX European Cup event.
- All riders in Championships categories require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Cup Rounds.
- If the number of Championship riders registered is 12 or less the categories will be combined.

The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event of the UEC BMX European Cup events.

Rider's equipment:

- All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.
- All Championship and Challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.
- If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:
 - o the jersey awarded by the federation,
 - o a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
 - o their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country

All riders, coaches, parents, commissaires, personnel and visitors must respect Covid-19 rules implemented on the venue by the organiser.

Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be on Friday, as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team; max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

11. ACCREDITATION

A Chef d'Equipe or his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Members of the country delegations will receive accreditation at all UEC events according to the following schedule if they register their staff. Please send an email to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event with the names of the staff members.

Athletes

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

National Teams

Each National Championships team must register their staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members) must be registered. Please send an email to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event. UCI teams have the same rights as national teams.

Chef d'Equipe

Each federation which registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all of its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list, on the scheduled day and times of registration.

Mandatory registration of staff before the event

Before each event a national federation must register their Chef d'Equipe and the whole team, the registration will be checked at the event. Please send an email with the names of the staff members to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license from the federations. UEC will check the registration of the staff and then they will be given the accreditation. Without a registration UEC will not give out accreditation.

National BMX coaches

UEC acknowledges official BMX National coaches for European Cup. National federations can register their coaches. They will be provided with accreditation per race. A country can register max 2 coaches per country per race.

Personal BMX coaches

Championships riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach are offered the possibility to buy a Coach accreditation. This accreditation costs €150 per weekend. This allows you access to the team manager meeting and coach area.

This coach accreditation can be bought at the Welcome Centre on Friday during rider confirmation.

12. 2023 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING**UEC Registered teams**

UEC teams (<http://www.uec.ch/en/teamsbmx>) must confirm their 4-rider participation on Friday before each event (see time schedule) at the Welcome Centre. Team managers have to fill-in the team Entry form at team confirmation. In return for the registration, they receive accreditation for the event.

Accreditation team manager

Teams only receive accreditation when they enter the team competition at the event. A UEC BMX team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or non-compliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team Spaces for UEC registered teams

UEC Teams must register team spaces as indicated in the event Technical Guide. The organiser will provide spaces for team tents to UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €150 per team space. This includes 1x free event entry ticket per team tent space paid for.

For all rules concerning UEC BMX European Cup Team Ranking see European Cup Team Rules document on UEC website (www.uec.ch/en/bmx-european-cup).

Team Spaces for other teams

The organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of € 200,00. These teams receive 1 free event ticket from the organizer per team tent (6x3m).

- Teams must leave before Sunday 3th September 2023 at 21:00h
- Team Tent area will be closed two hours after the races/practice end.
- The organisers will assign space locations.

13. PRIZE MONEY AND TROPHIES

Prize money Championship classes

The prize money will be paid directly by the organiser directly after the prize ceremony.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Prize money (per round)

The prize money will be increased by 10% with more than 1'000 participants registered per day.

2023 Overall Ranking Challenge Categories

The UEC 2023 Overall ranking will take into consideration all rounds.

The ranking of the 2023 BMX European Cup will only be established for all Challenge categories 13 years and over. Categories 12 years and younger will not have an overall ranking.

The 2023 Overall Ranking ceremony for all categories will be held after the award ceremony of Round 12 in Anadia (Portugal).

2023 Overall UEC BMX European Cup Teams Ranking

The overall award ceremony will be held after Round 12 of the 2023 UEC BMX European Cup with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will take into consideration all rounds.

The UEC BMX Commission will award Prizemoney to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

19. PARKING

A free parking place with amply capacity is situated next to the track for team leaders and officials. There is a second free car park with sufficient capacity for riders and visitors within walking distance of about 200 meters.

20. CATERING

21. SHOPS

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Cup.

22. PRESS

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

During the UEC BMX European Cup events accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC Press Officer. It mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.



General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
 - The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC press officer or his / her deputy.
 - During the events, five red Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
 - The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
 - A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 50 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
 - By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
 - Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
 - Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
 - It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
 - It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
 - A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.
- Drones
- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

23. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room at the bottom of the start ramp.
