

General:

The 2023 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist of 12 rounds. All rounds count.

Rounds 1 & 2: Verona (ITA)

Rounds 3 & 4: Zolder (BEL)

Rounds 5 & 6: Valmiera (LAT)

Rounds 7 & 8: Benátky nad Jizerou (CZE)

Rounds 9 & 10: Sviland (NOR)

Rounds 11 & 12: Anadia (POR)

All teams have to register through UEC, deadline 15th February 2023, in order to take part in the 2023 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition.

The registration form is published on the website www.uec.ch.

The overall award ceremony will be held with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX Commission will award Prizemoney to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

Registration

- Teams wanting to participate in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition must register a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders, aged 13 years and over.
- National Championship teams will also be allowed to participate in the team ranking.
- Each team pays a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline 15th February 2023) – UEC fee € 500,-.
- Riders from all classes are welcome to enter the regular UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition: Challenge (20 & 24') and Championship.
- Minimum age for team riders to register is 13 years and over.
- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach at the event.

Team confirmation

- UEC teams have to confirm their 4 rider participation before each event at team registration, according to the time schedule. Teams have to fill-in the Team Entry form before each event at Team Confirmation on Friday.
- A team manager can enter a team for the 1st day of the Competition, and a different team for the 2nd day of the competition. This can only be done on Friday at team confirmation.
- If a rider is not able to race or not racing at all on day 2, the team manager can enter a new rider for the 2nd day of competition. This must be done before the start of the motos on Day 2.

Competition

- Points will be given according to the UEC Points table.
- When classes are combined because it doesn't meet the minimum number of riders, only the results of the final are split per class.
This means a rider receives points for finished position during moto's and qualifying rounds.
The results of the motos and qualifying rounds will not be split.
After the result of the Final, each rider receives points for final position after split result.
The split result is also used for the podium ceremony.

Accreditation

- Each registered UEC Team receives 1 accreditation for the team manager per event when they enter their team for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition.
- The accreditation of a UEC BMX team manager is only valid during the UEC BMX European Cup.
- UEC Teams accreditation is only valid for an event when they enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- Accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team manager responsibilities

- A team manager is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. UEC Team manager accreditation has the following rights:
 - Free entry to track
 - Entry to staging
 - Entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
 - Entry to Team manager meeting
 - Entry to Team manager area

Team space

- A team tent space will not automatically be assigned to a UEC Team. A UEC team also has to register for the team tent space with the organiser of a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- UEC Teams that do not enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as any other team without UEC registration.
- A UEC registered team can rent a team tent space at the event of 6 x 3 m, at the cost of a maximum of € 150,00. Any additional space is also at the cost of € 150,00.

Non UEC teams

The Organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of a minimum of € 200,00.

Team area

UEC asks organisers to make a placement plan for the team area, to make it easy for riders to go to staging from the team area and from the finish line back to the team area.
