2023 UCI Cycling World Championships and 192nd UCI Congress

Dear President,

Following my invitation to the 192nd UCI Congress, the annual gathering of all UCI affiliated National Federations, which will take place on Thursday 3 August 2023 from 09.00 to 17.30 at the Scottish Events Campus (SEC), Exhibition Way, Glasgow G3 8YW, Great Britain, please find below the information related to the support that the UCI will be providing for your participation to the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships and 192nd UCI Congress.

UCI Solidarity Programme Support

To enable National Federations to participate in the UCI Congress and the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships, the UCI will once again support its Group 3 and 4 affiliated National Federations to attend the 192nd UCI Congress, the UCI Official Gala Dinner, the National Federations Seminar, and 11 days of the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided from 2 to 14 August 2023, with one twin bedded room per National Federation at the Clayton Hotel Glasgow City, located at 286 Clyde Street, Glasgow, G1 4AR, Great Britain.

Airport transfers

Transfers from Glasgow or Edinburgh airports or Glasgow Central station to the Clayton Hotel Glasgow City will be organised on 2 August 2023, and transfers from the hotel to Glasgow or Edinburgh airports or Glasgow Central station will be organised on 14 August 2023.

Local transportation

Transportation to and from the UCI Congress on 3 August 2023, transportation to and from the UCI National Federations Seminar, which will take place on 8 August 2023 from 9.00 to 13.00 at the Scottish Events Campus (SEC), Exhibition Way, Glasgow G3 8YW, Great Britain, and transportation to the UCI Official Gala Dinner on 12 August 2023 from 19.00 to 23.00 at the Kelvin Grove Art Gallery and Museum, Argyle Street, Glasgow G3 8AG, Great Britain will also be provided.

Furthermore, the president and the general secretary from each Group 3 and 4 affiliated National Federations will be given a ScotRail Train Pass valid for two weeks that accesses all Glasgow City venues.

Exceptional Financial Support

Moreover, we are pleased to offer financial support to Group 3 and 4 affiliated National Federations towards their travel expenses. Specifically, we will provide up to 1500 CHF for a president to travel and 2500 CHF towards an athlete participating in the championships.


Eligibility

In order to receive support from the UCI Solidarity Programme, affiliated National Federations in Groups 3 and 4 must send their confirmed travel arrangements and a copy of their visa to enter Scotland to the International Relations Department at internationalrelations@uci.ch no later than **14 July 2023**.

We hope that this support will enable more National Federations to participate in the UCI Congress and contribute to the development of cycling globally and enjoy the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships.
