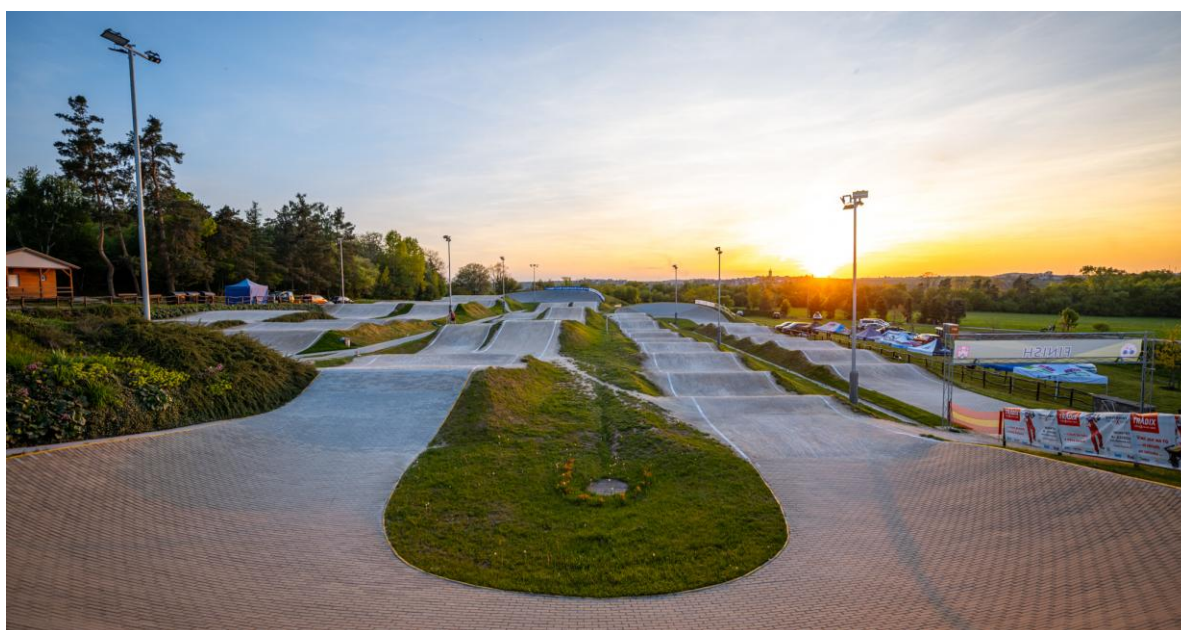

1. INTRODUCTION

2. TRACK DETAILS

The history of BMX racing in Benátky dates to the mid-80s last century. In new era, the new BMX track was built in 2008. Since then, the facility has been upgraded and constantly growing with the SX start hill since has taken place in 2020. That year with financial contribution of the ŠKODA AUTO a.s., Central Bohemian region and city of Benátky nad Jizerou, the 8m start hill was built and approved that year.

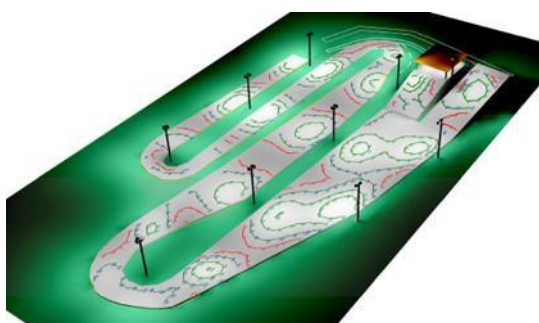

3. THE CITY OF BENATKY NAD JIZEROU

The first written mention of the village dates back to 1259. The town rights were transferred from Old Benátky in the 14th century, when a new town (New Benátky) was founded. In 1599, the famous Danish alchemist and astronomer Tycho Brahe was offered by Emperor Rudolf II to stay in an imperial



castle near Prague. He chose Benátky because of its favorable location for stargazing. The construction of the castle was led and completed by the imperial builder Giovanni Maria Filippi.



Brahe set up an alchemist's workshop there and sent the Emperor an elixir against the plague the same year. At the beginning of February 1600, another famous scholar, Johannes Kepler, came to visit Tycho Brahe. In the 19th century, Bedřich Smetana also worked as a music teacher for the Thun family. The merger of Old and New Benátky took place in 1944.

The main monument of the town is the Renaissance castle, which is covered with a sgraffito façade, the interior of the castle houses the regional museum (Tycho de Brahe Hall). Also worth a visit is the Church of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary at the castle with its tower. The chateau gardens and vineyards surrounding the chateau are worth a visit. You will also find <https://muzeumhracek.webpark.cz/>.

Then go to the prehistoric landscape <https://www.ceska-krajina.cz/rezervace/prirodni-rezervace-milovice/>. Bison and wild horses can be found in the grassland of Travina near Kbel, a district of Benátky nad Jizerou. You can reach the animal enclosure on foot from the bikros area.



Also worth mentioning in this area is a visit to the <https://mirakulum.cz/en/> park, which is definitely irresistible for children. Located in Milovice in central Bohemia, it is a land full of games, entertainment, trees, animals, and children's imagination. This unique 12-hectare entertainment and educational park was inspired by children's most secret wishes. To watch a video of the park, scan the QR code.

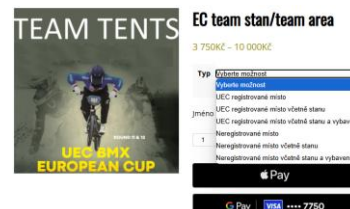

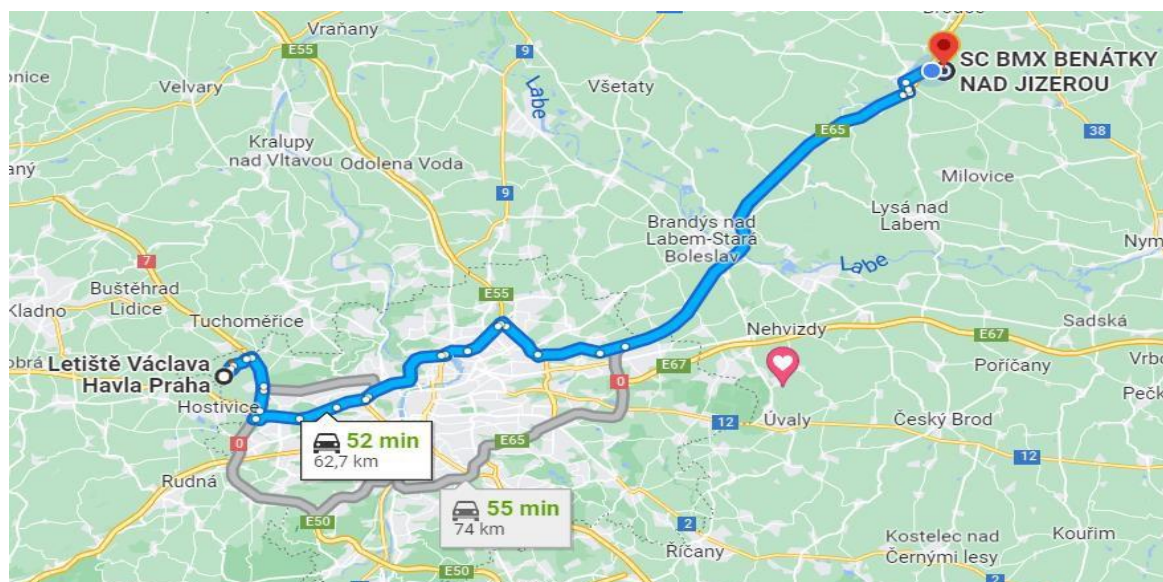
5. LOCATION

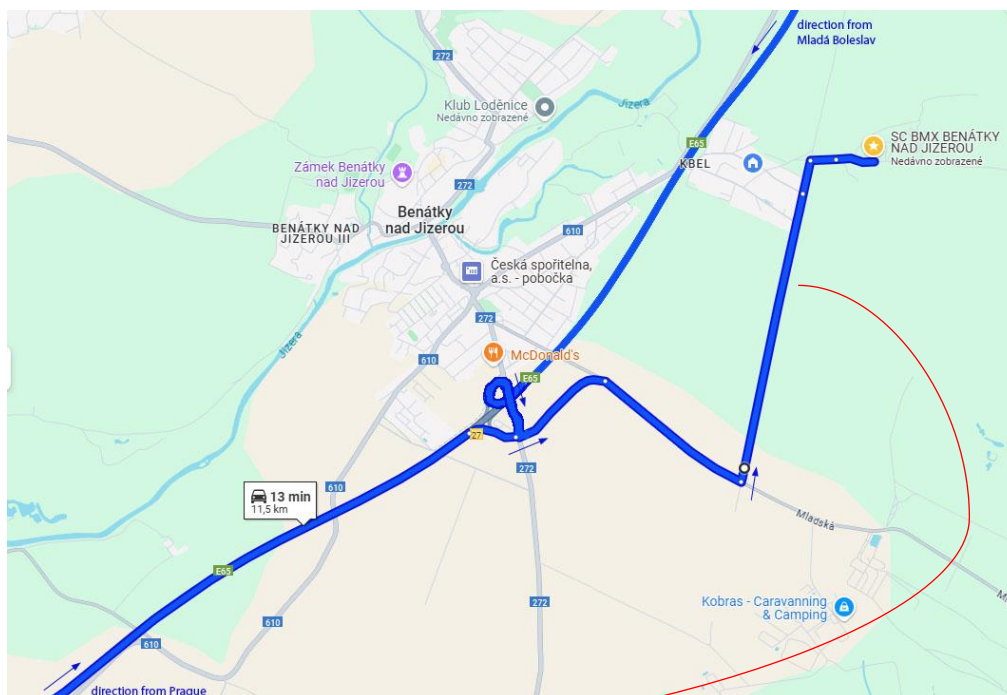

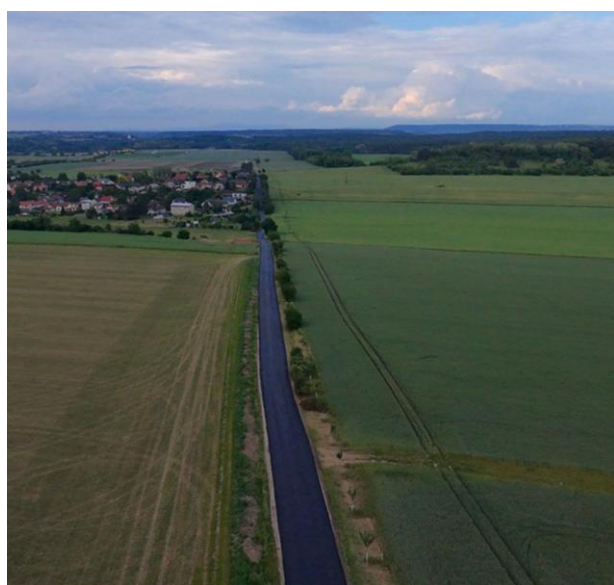


By car

Registration and payment details

- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly.
- *Administration fee is € 1,50 per rider, per round, per class.
- **Bank costs depend on your method of payment and will be charged directly.
- After registration you receive a confirmation mail from JSTiming.
Note: this email might be in your spam box.
- Cancellation costs are € 5,00 plus administration/bank costs € 1,50 per rider.
- After cancellation you receive a cancellation email from JSTiming.
- Refunds will follow after the deadline for cancellations.

Late entries

Late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for late entries, paying double entry fee. The deadline for late entries can be found on the event page in the registration portal. Registration or payment at the event are NOT POSSIBLE.

Extra Late entries

Extra late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for extra late entries, paying triple entry fee. The deadline for extra late entries can be found on the event page in the registration portal. Registration or payment at the event are NOT POSSIBLE.

Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations for this event is Monday 1 September 2025; 23:59 (CET) and can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

In case of a cancellation before the deadline, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per round) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

Cancellations after the deadline (Monday 1 September 2025; 23:59 CET) will not be refunded.

Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

Transponders

All riders in Challenge 15/16 and Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager. Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race.

If a rider fails to return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100.00 per transponder to the federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next UEC BMX European Cup round until the invoice is paid.

Above apply both for all races of the UEC BMX European Cup.

10. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Riders categories: as set forth in chapter 7.
- UEC BMX European Cup events are open to all riders who are licensed by a National Federation, with a minimum age of 8 years old. There is no limit in the number of riders a country can register.
- Event format Challenge categories: For all Challenge categories, excluded Boys 15/16 & Girls 15/16, scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event of the UEC BMX European Cup events.
- Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Event format Challenge category Boys 15/16, Girls 15/16 and Championship categories:

- The UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to articles 6.3.009 till 6.3.014 of the latest version of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- Riders are not automatically entered in both Rounds of each UEC BMX European Cup event. During riders confirmation on Friday, riders can opt to participate in only 1 Round during the UEC BMX European Cup event.
- All riders in Championships categories and Challenge 15/16 require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Cup Rounds. The rider is responsible to have the assigned transponder correctly attached to the bike at all times during racing, warmup and practice.

Rider's equipment:

- All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.
- All Championship and Challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.
- If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:
 - o the jersey awarded by the federation,
 - o a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
 - o their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be on Friday, as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team; max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

11. ACCREDITATION

A Chef d'Equipe or his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Members of the country delegations will receive accreditation at all UEC events according to the following schedule if they register their staff. Please send an email to j.polkamp@uec.ch before the event with the names of the staff members.

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

National Teams

Each National Championships team must register their staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members). Please send an email to j.polkamp@uec.ch with the names of staff and their roles in the event before the event. UCI teams have the same rights as national teams.

Chef d'Equipe

Each federation that pre-registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all of its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list at rider confirmation, as indicated in the timing schedule.

Mandatory registration of staff before the event

Before each event a national federation must register their Chef d'Equipe and the whole team, the registration will be checked at the event. Please send an email with the names of the staff members to j.polkamp@uec.ch before the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license from the federations. UEC will check the registration of the staff and then they will be given the accreditation. Without a registration UEC will not give out accreditation.

National BMX coaches

UEC acknowledges official BMX National coaches for European Cup. National federations can register their coaches. They will be provided with accreditation per race. A country can register max 2 coaches per country per race.

Personal BMX coaches

Championships riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach are offered the possibility to buy a Coach accreditation. This accreditation costs €150 per weekend. This allows you access to the team manager meeting and coach area. This coach accreditation can be bought at the Welcome Centre on Friday during rider confirmation.

12. 2025 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING & TEAM AREA

UEC Registered teams

UEC teams must confirm their 4-rider participation on Friday at rider confirmation before each event (see time schedule). Team managers have to fill-in the team Entry form. In return for the registration, they receive accreditation for the event.

Accreditation team manager

Teams only receive accreditation when they enter the team competition at the event. A UEC BMX team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or non-compliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team Spaces for UEC registered teams

UEC Teams must register team spaces as indicated in the event Technical Guide. The organiser will provide spaces for team tents to UEC registered teams, or 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €150 (3750 CZK) per team space. This includes 1x free event entry ticket (pass-partout) per team tent space paid for.

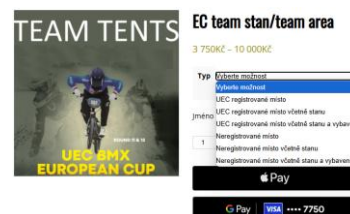

13. PRIZE MONEY AND TROPHIES

Prize money Championship classes

The prize money will be paid by bank transfer by the organiser after the event. After prize ceremony riders are request to deliver his bank details to the organizer.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Prize money (per round)

The prize money will be increased by 10% with more than 1.000 participants registered per day.

The 2025 Overall Ranking ceremony for all categories will be held after the award ceremony of Round 12.

The overall award ceremony will be held after Round 12 in Benátky (Czechia) of the 2025 UEC BMX European Cup with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will take into consideration all rounds.

The UEC BMX Commission will award prize money to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

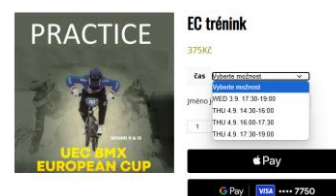

18. LIVESTREAM

All UEC BMX European Cup rounds are broadcasted live on UEC website: www.uec.ch

19. PARKING

A free parking place with amply capacity is situated next to the track for team managers and officials. At a walking distance of about 250 meters there is a second free, amply parking space for riders and visitors.

20. CATERING

There will be several refreshment stands near the race track where you can buy hot and cold food and drinks.

Breakfast will also be on the menu. There will also be a stand open with delicious coffee and homemade cakes.

21. SHOPS

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Cup.

If you would like your shop to be present during the 11&12 rounds European BMX, send an e-mail to pavel@bmxbenatky.cz to reserve your space in the BMX Village or ask for more information.

Mention your shop name, the person responsible, your time of arrival and how much space you need.

22. PRESS

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

During the UEC BMX European Cup events accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC. It is mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC official.
- During the events, five red Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

Drones

- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

23. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room at the bottom of the start ramp. The medical team will be available at the following times:

- Sunday - Detailed schedule provided after registration closes.
