## 1 INTRODUCTION

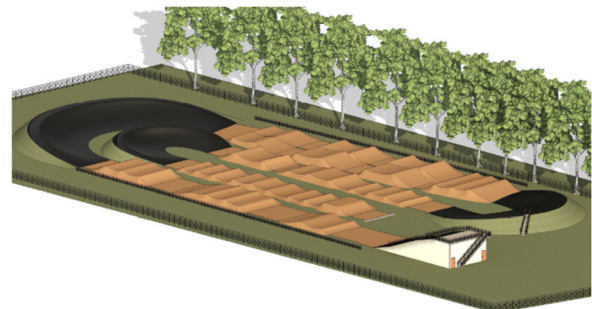
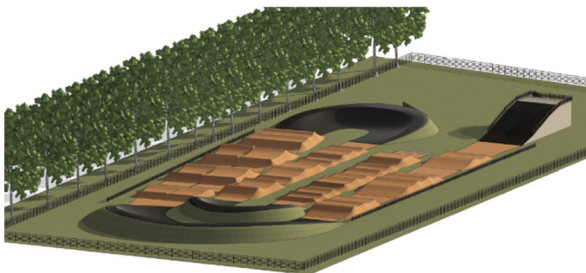

Recent work carried out by a specialized French company (RR TRACKS) has also modernized it to make it even more attractive. Equipped with a 5 m metal-framed starting mound, asphalt bends and a PRO section, its particularly popular obstacle sequences require speed and technicality.

### Rider Confirmation

All Team Managers/Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome Center to confirm their participation for the event.

### Transponders

All riders in the Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) and Challenge 15/16 require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe/Team Manager. Immediately after the race, the transponders of each country must be returned by the Team Manager. If a rider does not return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100 per transponder to the Federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next round of the UEC BMX European Cup until the invoice has been paid.

This applies to all races in the UEC BMX European Cup. The 2025 registration fees, excluding administration fee\* and bank costs\*\* are the following:

Challenge Classes :	€37 per entry, per round
Challenge 15 - 16 :	€42 per entry, per round (including transponder)
Junior Classes:	€50 per entry, per round (including transponder)
U23 Classes :	€60 per entry, per round (including transponder) (70 € if the rider U23 chooses to compete in the elite class)
Elite Classes:	€ 70 per entry, per round (including transponder)

In the event that the European Cup rounds cannot take place due to unpredictable circumstances (weather conditions, pandemic, etc.), the UEC cannot be held responsible. Therefore, the registration fees cannot be refunded.

Above apply both for all races in the UEC BMX European Cup.

### Registration and payment details

- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly.
- \*Administration fee is € 1,50 per rider, per round, per class.
- \*\*Bank costs depend on your method of payment and will be charged directly.
- After registration you receive a confirmation mail from JSTiming.  
*Note: this email might be in your spam box.*
- Cancellation costs are € 5,00 plus administration/bank costs € 1,50 per rider.
- After cancellation you receive a cancellation email from JSTiming.
- Refunds will follow after the deadline for cancellations.

### Late entries

Late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for late entries, paying double entry fee. The deadline for late entries can be found on the event page in the registration portal.

### Extra Late entries

Extra late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for extra late entries, paying triple entry fee. The deadline for extra late entries can be found on the event page in the registration portal.

**Registration or payment on site is NOT POSSIBLE**

### Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

In case of a cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per round) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

### Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

## 10 RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Riders Categories: as set in Chapter 8.
- The UEC BMX European Cup events are open to all licensed riders authorized by their national federation, with a minimum age of 8 years old. There is no limit in the number of riders a country can enter.

### Event format Challenge categories:

For all Challenge categories, excluded Boys 15/16 & Girls 15/16, scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.

- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event of the UEC BMX European Cup events.
- Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

### Event format Challenge category Boys 15/16, Girls 15/16 and Championship categories:

- The UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to articles 6.3.009 till 6.3.014 of the latest version of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- Riders are not automatically entered in both Rounds of each UEC BMX European Cup event. During riders confirmation on Friday, riders can opt to participate in only 1 Round during the UEC BMX European Cup event.
- All riders in the Championship and Challenge 15/16 categories need a UEC transponder to participate in the rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup. The rider is responsible for having the assigned transponder properly attached to the bike at all times during the race, warm-up and training.
- If the number of confirmed riders in a category is less than or equal to 12, the categories will be combined.

### Rider's equipment

- All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.
- All Championship and Challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.
- If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:
  - the jersey awarded by the federation,
  - a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
  - their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country

### Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be on Friday, as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for:

- max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe);
- max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team;
- max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team,
- max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

## 11 ACCREDITATION

A Chef d'Equipe or his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Members of the country delegations will receive accreditation at all UEC events according to the following schedule if they register their staff.

### Athletes

All athletes will be given a wristband so they can reach all the necessary areas.

### National Teams

Each National Championships team must register their staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members). Please send an email to [j.polkamp@uec.ch](mailto:j.polkamp@uec.ch) with the names of staff and their roles in the event before the event. UCI teams have the same rights as national teams.

### Chef d'Equipe

Each federation that pre-registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all of its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list at rider confirmation, as indicated in the timing schedule.

### **Mandatory registration of staff before the event**

Before each event a national federation must register their Chef d'Equipe and the whole team, the registration will be checked at the event. Please send an email with the names of the staff members to [j.polkamp@uec.ch](mailto:j.polkamp@uec.ch) before the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license from the federations. UEC will check the registration of the staff and then they will be given the accreditation. Without a registration UEC will not give out accreditation.

### **National BMX coaches**

UEC acknowledges official BMX national coaches for European Cup. National federations have to register their coaches to the accreditation system. They will be provided with accreditation per race. A country can register a maximum of 2 coaches per country per race.

### **BMX Personal Trainers**

Championship riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach have the option to purchase a COACH PASS from the organiser. This COACH PASS costs €150 per weekend. This gives you access to the team manager's meeting and the coach area. This COACH PASS can be purchased at the Welcome Center on Fridays between 9:00 and 10:00.

## **12 2025 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING & TEAM AREA**

### **UEC Registered Teams**

UEC teams must confirm their 4-rider participation on Friday at rider confirmation before each event (see time schedule). Team managers have to fill-in the team Entry form. In return for the registration, they receive accreditation for the event.

### **Team Manager accreditation**

Teams only receive accreditation when they register for the event's team competition. A UEC BMX Team Manager or his/her nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted area in order to perform his/her duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or non-compliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaire's panel.

### **Team spaces for UEC registered teams**

The organiser will provide spaces for team tents to **UEC registered teams** of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €150 per team space, as close as possible to the track. This includes 1 x free entry ticket per team tent space paid. It is possible to buy additional space at the same price (€150). It is also possible to rent a tent at a rate of €150 (in addition to the space and subject to availability).

For all the rules concerning UEC BMX European Cup Team Ranking, see European Cup Team Rules document on UEC website ([UEC BMX Team Regulations 2025](#)).

### **Team Spaces for All Other Teams**

The organiser will provide tent spaces for teams tents to **no-UEC registered teams**, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at a cost of €200. This includes 1 x free entry ticket per paid space. It is possible to buy additional space at the same price (€200). It is also possible to rent a tent at a rate of €200 (in addition to the space and subject to availability).

A reservation for a TEAM area (UEC or Non-UEC) includes a TEAM AREA / PUBLIC AREA bracelet and a TEAM AREA PASS (to be collected at the Visitor Center). It is possible to purchase a second TEAM AREA PASS / PUBLIC SPACE at the Visitor Centre during the TEAM AREA accreditation at the price of €60 (valid for the whole weekend). A parking place will be available with the TEAM AREA PASS.

**TEAM AREA Rules**

- Check-in will be allowed from Thursday, May 8 from 2:00 p.m
- The dismantling of tents is allowed until Sunday 20:00.
- The tent area is closed two hours after the end of the rounds.
- The Organizer will assign the pitches in the order of arrival of the reservations

In case of any problems during the event you can contact a member of the club's staff (contact details provided on arrival).

No cars or other motorized vehicles will be allowed on the team's pit lane (except for drop-off on Thursday and Friday until 12 noon maximum). A Team Manager car park is located nearby.

**13 PRIZE AND TROPHIES**

**Prize money Championship classes:**

The prize will be paid to the riders by bank transfer. Please provide your Iban code after the podium ceremony.

The acceptance of the transfer of the prize money will only be given upon presentation of the UCI license of the riders.

**Podium ceremony**

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

**Prize money (per round)**

The prize money will be increased by 10% with more than 1.000 participants registered per day.

The UEC will proceed payment by the end of November 2025 through the riders' National Cycling Federation.

**2025 Overall Ranking Challenge Categories**

The UEC 2025 Overall ranking will take into consideration all rounds.

The ranking of the 2025 BMX European Cup will only be established for all Challenge categories 13 years and over. Categories 12 years and younger will not have an overall ranking.

The 2025 Overall Ranking ceremony for all categories will be held after the award ceremony of Round 12.

**2025 Overall UEC BMX European Cup Teams Ranking**

The overall award ceremony will be held after Round 12 in Benatky nad Jizerou (Czechia) of the 2025 UEC BMX European Cup with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will take into consideration all rounds.

The UEC BMX Commission will award prize money to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

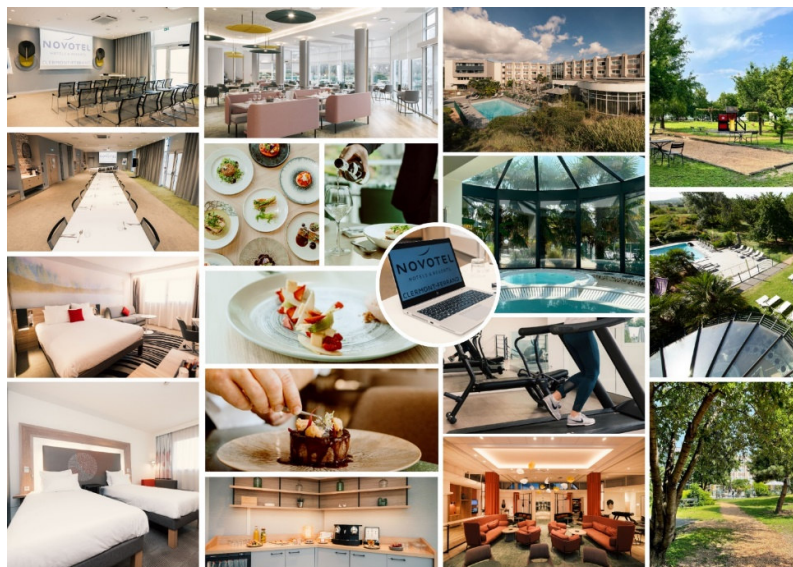

## 19 PARKING

A free parking space with a large capacity is located next to the track for team managers and officials. At a walking distance of about 200 meters, there is a second free parking lot, amply available for riders and visitors.

## 20 CATERING

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Cup.

## 22 PRESS

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

During the UEC BMX European Cup events accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC. It mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

### General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC official.
- During the events, five orange Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

### Drones

Given the proximity to the airport and federal regulations, drones are not allowed.
