## Professional Summary :

As President of the Balkan Cycling Union (2012–2016) and a Management Board Member of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), he successfully positioned the BCU as a pivotal organization in European and global cycling. In 2023, Mr. Müftüoğlu resumed the presidency of the BCU, tackling financial challenges, stabilizing the Union, and launching programs aimed at elevating cycling standards across the Balkans. His efforts have laid the groundwork for sustainable growth by fostering collaboration among national cycling federations, improving athlete performance, and organizing high-profile international competitions.



Mr. Emin Müftüoğlu's Leadership and Contributions include:

- Managing and organizing over thirty races annually on the UCI calendar, strengthening global cycling presence and providing neighboring countries with opportunities to participate in international events in the region.
- Hosting and leading the organization of the Presidential Cycling Tour of Türkiye, a globally recognized UCI ProSeries event, along with major international competitions such as the European Championships in MTB and Road Cycling, as well as the upcoming World Championships in MTB Eliminator and the UCI Track Nations Cup.
- Investing in athlete development by establishing and enhancing training facilities like the Konya Velodrome and Sakarya BMX Park.
- Collaborating with UEC and UCI on initiatives to transform these facilities into training centers for Balkan nations.
