6. EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with the local organising committee (LOC) will organize the 2025 UEC Cyclo-Cross Youth & Masters European Championships held on 14-16 November 2025 in Samorin (SVK).
- 1.2** The event will be organized in accordance with the rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.
- 1.3** Entrants for European Championships shall hold licenses issued by a Federation affiliated to the UEC.
- 1.4** Riders ages shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules (5.1.001). The category which will be applied for entries to races for the entire season is the category to which the rider will belong on 1 January of the following calendar year
- 1.5** Body numbers
The riders are obliged to use the body-numbers which will be supplied by the organization. Changes to these are not allowed.
- 1.6** Unforeseen
In those cases in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC Technical delegate and the organization (where applicable), will decide.

ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF THE EVENTS

2.1 Categories of riders

Youth

The UEC Cyclo-Cross Youth European Championships events shall be open to the following age categories:

- ✓ Women 13 Year of birth 2013
- ✓ Women 14 Year of birth 2012
- ✓ Women 15 Year of birth 2011
- ✓ Women 16 Year of birth 2010
- ✓ Men 13 Year of birth 2013
- ✓ Men 14 Year of birth 2012
- ✓ Men 15 Year of birth 2011
- ✓ Men 16 Year of birth 2010

All the categories listed above must start in a separate race.

3.3 Participation fees

Youth categories

The registration fee for the 13, 14, 15 & 16 categories is €20.

Entry on the day is not available.

Master categories

Entry fee: The hereafter conditions will be applied for the participation of the 2025 UEC Cyclo-Cross Masters European Championships:

- **€ 40 from 3 June to 30 June 2025**
- **€ 50 from 1 July to 31 August 2025**
- **€ 60 from 1 September to 5 November 2025**

Entry on the day is not available.

3.4 Attendants

Each rider may be accompanied by a paramedical assistant and two mechanics.

The paramedical assistant and the mechanics must be provided by the organizer with a bracelet, which gives them access to the start / finish zone or the pit area.

The riders are asked to prepare in advance the list of assistants working in the start / finish area and in the pit area. They will be registered during the license check. Only those declared assistants will be allowed to receive bracelets to access the start / finish zone or the pit area.

The bracelets must be worn by the people confirmed. These bracelets give access to the course without accreditation.

ARTICLE 4. START ORDER

The start order will be as follows:

- Youth categories:

Qualifications: by drawing lots

Finals: if qualifications, based on the results; if no qualifications by drawing lots

- Master categories:

Defending 2024 European champion of the category concerned.

According to the order of the on-line registration.

ARTICLE 5. ALLOCATION OF START NUMBERS

Race numbers are allocated according to the order of the on-line registration.

ARTICLE 6. ALLOCATION OF BOXES IN THE PITS AREA

For each category the pit boxes are not allocated and are free to use according to own discretion of mechanics.

ARTICLE 7. CLOTHING

The design of the jersey or advertising is not limited except of the UCI World champion Masters jersey

ARTICLE 8. OTHER RULES

1. The races of UEC Cyclo-Cross Youth & Masters European Championships are run under decisions, conditions and instructions of UEC.
2. Wearing a rigid safety helmet shall be mandatory during competitions and training sessions.
3. Bicycles used for Cyclo-Cross races must comply with UCI regulations.
4. For the cyclo-cross bicycle the width of the tyres (measured between the widest parts) shall not exceed 33 mm and it may not incorporate any form of spike or stud (1.3.018).
5. Using of disc brakes are allowed in cyclo-cross training and competition (1.3.025).
6. For races on the road and cyclo-cross, the use of fixed sprocket is forbidden: a braking system that acts on both wheels is required.
7. Personal high-pressure cleaners are forbidden in the pit area during the championships.

ARTICLE 9 - AWARD CEREMONIES / JERSEY & MEDALS

Every European Championship rider will be awarded with:

The 1st place:	Gold medal and Champion(s) jersey
The 2nd place:	Silver medal
The 3rd place:	Bronze medal

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony.

Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear in their racing attire but bare-headed and without headband or glasses, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure.

Riders must present themselves at the podium as per the published schedule.

ARTICLE 10 - ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

ARTICLE 11 PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is applicable for all races entered in the UCI calendar.

Article 12 - RESPONSIBILITIES

The Organizer and the UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The Organizer and the UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident. For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.

7. PARKING & PUBLIC

Parking:

Available directly in the resort free of charge for standard vehicle. Fees will apply for the Motorhomes and Campers.
