
2 GENERAL INFORMATION

- Course configuration - LAST LAP FINISHLINE Y

The European Gravel 2025 Championships takes place over multiple laps with passages in the finish area. In order to highlight the athletes at the finish line, 2 different lanes are provided in the finish area:

- one is reserved for the transit of competitors who have yet to make more laps(left arrow marked LAP)
- one reserved for athletes who are finishing the race. (right arrow marked FINISH)

Please follow the provided signposting correctly (see sign on the right).



- Startboxes will open at 10:00
- Age groups → First come, first served
- Elite > based on a points system that is a cumulation of the following points:
 - Points won during the UEC Gravel European Championship of the previous year in the elite category
 - 50% of the points in the UCI rankings road, mountain bike cross country (XCO), mountain bike marathon (XCM) and cyclocross

5 RACE PROCEDURES GENERAL INFORMATION

Race Numbers

- All categories will have different colors of back numbers so that riders are not confused and know their opponents
- Males and females of the same age group do have the same color of back number
- The start time of your group is the GUN time of your start, meaning that your position at the finish line is also your result in the race!
- Back number and number plate is mandatory!
- Back number on the RIGHT side!

Jersey

- All riders are free to ride in their national, team or club jersey
- Reigning World Champions should wear their rainbow jersey

SPORTING ASPECTS RULES REMINDERS

General

- No Radios allowed!
- Once finished, all riders have to go out of course asap
- No cameras allowed
- No following cars or motos!

Race & lapped riders

- Course is closed for traffic until 18:00
- Lapped riders, by the leader of the race, can finish their lap, but will be pulled at the finish
- Cut-off time at start last lap → 15:30

- Teams/helpers can give food/drinks and can give mechanical support
- The organizer provides a stand with Enervit food and drinks
- Feed/tech zone = waste zone

Handing out food and drinks or changing wheels outside these zones means

disqualification!

Bikes

Any type of bike with dropped handlebars is allowed

- Gravel bike
- Road bike
- Cyclocross bike

The bike should be minimum 6.8kg (without bottles, GPS device)

There is no minimum or maximum tyre width

Podium Ceremonies

- Directly after the finish
- Mandatory in race jersey (bib + shirt)
- No hats, caps, sunglasses, open shoes
- → Piazza II Risorgimento (at the finish) in front of the Cathedral

The official ceremonies will begin at 16:00.

General Rules

- All age categories, even starting together, will have separate results and titles, even if there
 is only 1 rider at the start
- Control timing points will be positioned at strategic places on all loops of the course plus at the start and finish line

- We only accept an official complaint before the podium ceremonies
- The awarding of the European Gravel Champion title is not foreseen for the 19–34 age category, and therefore no official ceremony will be held for this category.
