You must present your Parking Card to the steward to enter the parking area. One color = one day. No Parking Card, no access.










Presentation Teams

- Start podium
- Timing: according to time schedule in envelope
- Be present 5 min before presentation
- Finished 10 min before start

PPO to Finish

- Take the same route back (Follow le pouzin then A7 road then take the A7 motorway, exit at number 15 Valence Sud, and continue to Guilherand-Granges
- Travel time between the finish and the start is about 40 minutes
- When you reach the PPO in Guilherand-Granges, follow the signage







Road races

- Neutral technical service will be provided by team Vittoria with 3 neutral cars and one moto.
- The frequency of Radio Tour will be 157,550Mhz and the announcer will be Ms. Christel Reille.
- Respect the order of the team cars.
- Feeding will be allowed from km 30 until last passage from the boxes in the last lap.

- Feeding will be allowed from team cars. Stationary feeding will be allowed only in the two fixed zones: Rue Gagarine and Route de Châteaubourg.
- Concerning the feed zone in Rue Gagarine, only persons with accreditation and official armband will be allowed in that zone. Please also tell your assistants to stay behind the white line painted on the road. Armbands must be returned to the commissaires in the boxes after the last race.
- Team boxes are assigned and your number is visible on the official communique.
- Green zones are confirmed as it is described in the technical guide.
- Use of the radio communication won't be allowed.
- Tell your riders to raise up their hand when they need their team car and to clearly indicate whether they need feeding or assistance because of a technical problem.

- Any rider dropped who is over more than 15 minutes behind the peloton, may be eliminated by the Commissaires. They must remove their bib and give it to the Commissaire or to the broom car.
- If they wish to ride to the end, they must comply with vehicle traffic laws and NOT cross the finish line.
- Riders on the circuit who are about to be overtaken will be stopped at the finish line.
- The time limit may be adjusted by the commissaires panel in consultation with the organisation.

Medical issues

In case of medical issues, it will be possible to change starting riders until 6pm of the day before each race.

Feed zone Youri Gagarine (near the finish)

- Only staf with armbands.
- Respect the 1m line

Team presentation & signage

In compliance with article 2.3.009 UCI regulations, teams are required to turn up (all riders together) at the presentation in the following order and at the time listed in the communiqué.

Team cars

- The teams' car order for each category will be listed in a communiqué.
- In addition to the windscreen band, team cars bear on the rear window a sticker specifying the vehicle's place. This number is allocated by the commissaires' panel.
- Stickers will be distributed before every race at the parking.
- A separate color has been used for each category.



- Award ceremony for the first 3 riders will be organised no later than 10 minutes after the last rider crossing the finish line.
- Riders on the podium without cap and/or glasses.

Award ceremony

Only with ceremony pass.
