6. EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Article 1 - GENERAL RULES

1.1 The Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with Boucles Drôme Ardèche Organisation and French Cycling Federation will organise the 2025 UEC Road European Championships held on 1 – 5 October in Drôme-Ardèche region (France).

1.2 The events will be organised in accordance with the rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.

1.3 The Championships including Road Races, Time Trials and Team Time Trials Mixed Relay (Juniors/U23/Elite) may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team only.

1.4 As per Article 3 (below), for the Junior's Team Time Trial Mixed Relay, nations in the UCI Groups 3 and 4, can compose **Combined Nations**.

UCI Federations classification 2024 – 2025

- **Group 3:** Andorra, Bulgaria, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Malta, Serbia, Ukraine, Vatican City
- **Group 4:** Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Georgia, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Rep. of Moldova

1.5 The riders to contest each Championship shall be confirmed by an official of their Federation to the Commissaires during the confirmation procedure, before the start of the Team Managers meeting.

1.6 Riders ages shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules.

1.7 Body numbers.

The riders are obliged to use the body numbers which will be supplied by the organisation. Body numbers may not be folded or altered.

1.8 Unforeseen.

In those cases, in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC Technical coordinator and the organization (where applicable), will decide.

Article 2 - TYPE OF THE EVENTS

2.1 Categories

The Championships are open to riders from the categories:

- **Women Junior**
- **Men Junior**

- **Women U23**
- **Men U23**

- **Women Elite**
- **Men Elite**

It is entered on the UCI calendar as a Continental Championships event (UCI CC).

Article 3 - PARTICIPATION

National Federations may enter the following riders per Championship:

3.1 Team Time Trial Mixed Relay:

Elite 1 team of 6 riders per nation as follows:

Each national team must be composed by a total of six (6) riders of Elite and/or Under 23 age categories:

- three (3) men and three (3) women of the same nationality.

Junior 1 team of 6 riders per nation as follows:

Each national team must be composed by a total of six (6) junior riders:

- three (3) men junior and three (3) women junior of the same nationality.

3.2 Individual Time Trial

Junior categories

3 riders per nation / per category

Elite and U23 categories

2 riders per nation / per category

- A National Federation shall be entitled to enter riders of 19 years or more in the Elite individual Time Trial. In that case, such riders may not participate in the U23 Individual Time Trial in the same year.
- U23 riders must race in the same category (Elite or U23) for the individual time trial and the road race if they compete in both events.
- U23 riders who have participated in the Men Elite individual Time Trial or Women Elite individual Time Trial at a previous UEC European Championships or at a previous UCI World Championships (women only in 2025) may not participate in the Men U23 or Women U23 individual Time Trial.
- Men U23 riders who are registered with a UCI WorldTeam or a UCI ProTeam are not authorised to participate in the individual time trial for U23 riders. Such restriction does not apply to U23 riders registered as trainees with UCI WorldTeams or UCI ProTeams.

3.3 Road race

Women Junior, Men Junior, Women U23, Men U23

6 riders per nation / per category

- U23 riders who have participated in the Men or Women Elite Road race at a previous UEC Road European Championships or at a previous UCI Road World Championships (women only in 2025) may not participate in the U23 road race.
- U23 riders must race in the same category (Elite or U23) for the individual time trial and the road race if they compete in both events.
- Men U23 riders who are registered with a UCI WorldTeam or a UCI ProTeam are not authorised to participate in the road race for U23 riders. Such restriction does not apply to U23 riders registered as trainees with UCI WorldTeams or UCI ProTeams.

Women Elite, Men Elite

UCI Nation Ranking, published on the 1st August 2025.

- nations ranked 1 to 5: 8 riders
- nations ranked 6 to 10: 6 riders
- nations ranked 11 to 20: 4 riders
- nations ranked 21 to 40: 2 riders
- nations ranked 41 to 50 or non-ranked nations 1 rider

Note 1: Unused quota places will be reallocated to nations ranked 11 to 50 or non-ranked nations.

Note 2: The hosting nation will be allowed to enter the maximum quota.

- A National Federation may enter riders of 19 years of age or more in the Elite road race. In that case, such riders may not participate in the U23 road race in that same year.

In accordance with the riders' registration, the National Federations may add to the above-mentioned numbers of riders:

- max 2 reserve riders per category for the Time Trials
- max 2 men reserve riders and 2 women reserve riders for the Elite/U23 Team Time Trials Mixed Relay
- max 1 junior man reserve rider and 1 junior woman reserve rider for the Juniors Team Time Trials Mixed Relay
- max 4 reserve riders per category for the Road Races

The team managers of the national teams must present the national jersey and shorts to the College of Commissioners for validation upon confirmation of the starters.

INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIALS – SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Article 1 – Participation

The events are reserved for the riders from the following categories:

These events are open to national teams.

Article 2 – Procedures before start

Confirmation of riders and distribution of bibs as per points 3.4 and 3.5.

Article 3 – Starting order

The start lists for the **individual time trials** will be prepared by the College of Commissaires and the UEC Technical Coordinator taking into consideration various objective criteria such as the UCI classifications and the recent results of each rider.

The riders will start with at identical intervals of one minute.

Article 4 – Equipment check

Riders must attend the equipment check at least 15 minutes before their start time. All bikes will be checked using a measuring jig that complies with UCI Regulations. Once checked, bikes will not be allowed outside the start area. A pre-check of bikes will be organized one hour before the first rider starts. Teams may present their bikes for checking at this time.

A pre-check of bikes will also be organized on Tuesday, 30 September 2025 from 11:00 till 18:00, Agora Centre, 222 avenue Georges Clemenceau, 07500 Guilherand-Granges.

Article 5 – Technical neutral service

VITTORIA will be responsible for neutral assistance using 3 vehicles.

Article 6 – Following vehicles

Team vehicles will be able to follow their team.

If a national team needs a vehicle to follow its rider, this must be announced and declared by the team managers, to the commissaires during the starters' confirmation. Feeding of riders from following vehicles is prohibited.

Article 7 – Split times

One (1) intermediate timing point will be set up. Timing gaps will be communicated on Radio-Tour.

Article 8 – Hot seat and awards ceremony

As part of TV production, a "Hot Seat" will highlight the 3 best riders with the best 3 provisional times.

The "Hot Seat" is installed on the award ceremony podium as an extension of the finish line. Immediately after their arrival, the riders having established the best provisional times will join the "Hot Seat", guided by an escort put in place by the organization. As soon as those 3 best times are beaten, the riders will give way to the new riders at the top of the provisional classification and so on.

The team managers will take care to inform the riders and the assistants of the teams of these provisions.

Awards Ceremony

The first 3 riders of each event will present themselves for the ceremonial ceremony no later than 10 minutes after the last rider has crossed the finish line.

UEC awards a European Champion jersey to the winner. Each rider on the podium receives a medal.

TEAM TIME TRIAL MIXED RELAY – SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Article 1 - Participation

The events are reserved for the following teams:

Each Elite/U23 team participating in the team time trial mixed relay can register five (5) men and five (5) women, of which three (3) men and three (3) women will start.

Each Junior team participating in the team time trial mixed relay can register five (5) men and five (5) women, of which three (3) men and three (3) women will start.

Each Junior Combined team participating in the team time trial mixed relay can register five (5) men and five (5) women, of which three (3) men and three (3) women will start.

This event is open to national teams and national combined teams (only for juniors).

Article 2 - Procedures before start

Confirmation of riders and distribution of bibs as per point 3.4 and 3.5.

Article 3 – Starting order

The teams will start at identical intervals, set by the organisers, depending on the number of teams, registered for the event.

The start list for the **team time trial mixed relay** will be prepared by the College of Commissaires and the UEC Technical Coordinator and taking into consideration the cumulative results of the last European Championships (2024 edition) and World Championships (2024 edition), where applicable.

The men will start first and relay the women of their team.

Article 4 – Equipment check

Riders must attend the equipment check at least 15 minutes before their start time. All bikes will be checked using a measuring jig that complies with UCI Regulations. Once checked, bikes will not be allowed outside the start area. A pre-check of bikes will be organized one hour before the first rider starts. Teams may present their bikes for checking at this time.

Article 5 - Following vehicles

Each team will be allowed to follow their riders in a maximum of one team vehicle per gender (type of the vehicle according to the UCI rules) accredited by the organization, providing technical assistance if necessary. The Team vehicle for the Men must take the deviation before the finish line and a second Team vehicle will follow the women.

Feeding from a following vehicle is prohibited.

Article 6 - Relay zone

At the start, the riders will be held side-by-side on the ramp and then released by the holders upon the relay signal, but without being pushed. The signal for the Women start, will be given by a flash light and by raising a flag. The riders must respect the instructions given by the Commissaires who will supervise the relay zone and assign the start lanes.

Article 7 - Split times

One (1) intermediate timing point will be set up at different locations.

A second (2) intermediate timing point will be set up in the finish line.

Timing gaps will be communicated on Radio-Tour.

The finish time will be taken on the 2nd rider of each team.

Article 8 - Hot seat and awards ceremony .

Hot seat

As part of TV production, a "Hot Seat" will accommodate the team with the best provisional time.

The "Hot Seat" is installed on the award ceremony podium as an extension of the finish line. Immediately after arrival, the team with the best provisional time will join the "Hot Seat", guided by an escort provided by the organisation.

As soon as the best time is beaten, the team will give way to the new team at the top of the provisional ranking and so on. A waiting area will be set up for Men waiting for Women to finish the race.

The team managers will take care to inform the riders and the assistants of the teams of these provisions.

Awards ceremony

An official ceremony will be organized immediately after the arrival of the last team.

The riders and team managers of the first 3 teams will present themselves for the ceremony immediately after the passage of the last team on the finish line.

The UEC awards a European Champion jersey to each of the riders of the winning team. Each rider of the teams on the podium receives a medal.

ROAD RACES – SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Article 1 - Participation

The events are reserved for riders from the following categories:

These events are open to national teams.

Article 2 - Procedures before start

Confirmation of riders and distribution of bibs as per point 3.4 and 3.5.

Signature

The entire national team must present themselves for the signing podium.

The signature podium will be open 45 minutes before each departure and will be closed 10 minutes before each departure. During the signature, national teams will be presented to the public and media, according to a schedule, set and communicated by UEC.

Riders who have not signed will not be able to start.

Article 3 - Radio communication between riders and the team managers

The use of headsets and any means of remote communication at the European Championships is prohibited.

Article 4 - Clothing apparel / equipment

All riders must compete in their national jersey but the World Champions will have to wear their rainbow jersey. Continental and National Champions must wear their national apparel / equipment.

Article 5 - Technical neutral assistance and feeding zone / waste zones

VITTORIA will provide neutral assistance for road races using 3 cars and 1 motorcycle.

A feeding/technical assistance zone will be located at the following address: rue Youri Gagarine, 07500 Guilherand-Granges (circuit des coteaux and final circuit)

A 2nd remote feeding zone will be located during road races at the following address: Route de Châteaubourg, 07130 Saint-Romain-de-Lerps (circuit des coteaux).

Waste zones will be located before and after the feeding/technical assistance zone. Riders must respect the environment and use the waste areas.

Breakdown and change of wheel or bicycle can be carried out directly by the teams in the feeding/technical assistant zone and / or by the team vehicle.

Feeding from the team vehicle will also be authorized, in accordance with the UCI Regulations.

Article 6 - Following vehicles

Breakdown assistance during the race from the vehicles of the team managers is authorized, in accordance with the following provisions:

Only one vehicle per nation is allowed to drive to the race level, in the following order:

- vehicles of nations according to the UEC lists;
- a maximum of 25 vehicles of national teams will be authorized in the race section. The groupings of nations will be communicated by the UEC after the confirmation of the starters.
- for individual riders who will not have a team vehicle in the race section, neutral assistance will be provided.

Within each group, the order is determined by the latest UCI rankings by nation. The order of the remaining unclassified nations is determined by lot.

For several nations sharing same vehicle, the highest ranked nation is taken into account.

Article 7 - Time limits

Any rider dropped who is over more than 15 minutes behind the peloton, may be eliminated by the Commissaires. They must remove their bib and give it to the Commissaire or to the broom car.

If they wish to ride to the end, they must comply with vehicle traffic laws and NOT cross the finish line.

Riders on the circuit who are about to be overtaken will be stopped at the finish line.

The time limit may be adjusted by the commissaires panel in consultation with the organisation.

Article 8 - Awards ceremony

The first 3 riders of the race will present themselves for the official ceremony no later than 10 minutes after the passage of the first rider on the finish line.

The team managers will take care to inform the riders and the assistants of the teams of these provisions.

UEC awards a European Champion jersey to the winning rider. Each rider on the podium receives a medal.

7. GENERAL INFORMATION ON RACES

7.1. RADIO TOUR

Race information will be transmitted by Radio Tour at each event. The frequency will be communicated during the team managers meeting.

The radios will be given to the team leaders at the accreditation centre on

Team managers must sign a form upon receipt and return of their radio set. €50 will be requested for the radio as deposit. It will be refunded when the radio will be returned.

The radios must be returned at the Team Parking in Guilherand-Granges on

- Friday, 3 October
- Saturday, 4 October
- Sunday, 5 October

within 1 hour after the end of the second race.

7.2. TEAM CARS

Team cars will be able to follow the race for all categories. In accordance with article 2.2.032 of the UCI regulations, the vehicles used must respect a maximum height of 1.66 meters (roof racks not included). These regulations do not apply for time trial races.

The order of team cars will be determined according to the provisions in the specific articles for the road races, in accordance with the number of riders by nation and safety criteria.

Nations with a reduced number of riders will be called upon to share the same vehicle.

7.3. CEREMONIES AND PRIZE LIST

At the end of each event the 3 best riders (teams) will receive:

- 1st place: The European Champion jersey and the Gold medal
- 2nd place: The Silver medal
- 3rd place: The Bronze medal

The European Champion, as well as the second and the third placed riders are obliged to be in time and ready for the awards ceremony that will be held after each race in the finish area.

Riders shall appear in racing attire, wearing their national jerseys but bare-headed and without headband or glasses, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure.

7.4. UCI POINTS SCALE

In accordance with the articles 2.10.008 and 2.10.017 of the UCI ranking points for the UCI Europe Tour WU, MU, WE and ME categories will be awarded.

7.5. ANTIDOPING CONTROLS

The event may be selected for doping controls either by the International Testing Agency (ITA) or by the National Antidoping Agency. If selected, doping controls will be conducted under the UCI Anti-Doping Rules. The antidoping tests will take place at the Antidoping Station located near the finish area.

7.6. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

7.7. RESPONSIBILITIES

The organizers and the UEC cannot, in any case, be held responsible in the event of accidents or material damage which may occur during official training and / or competitions.

The organizers and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

In all cases not provided for in the specific regulations, the UCI regulations will be applicable.

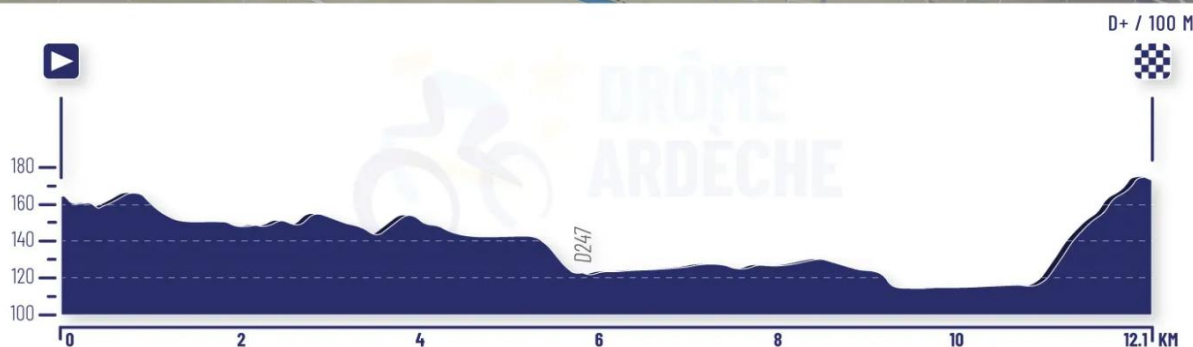

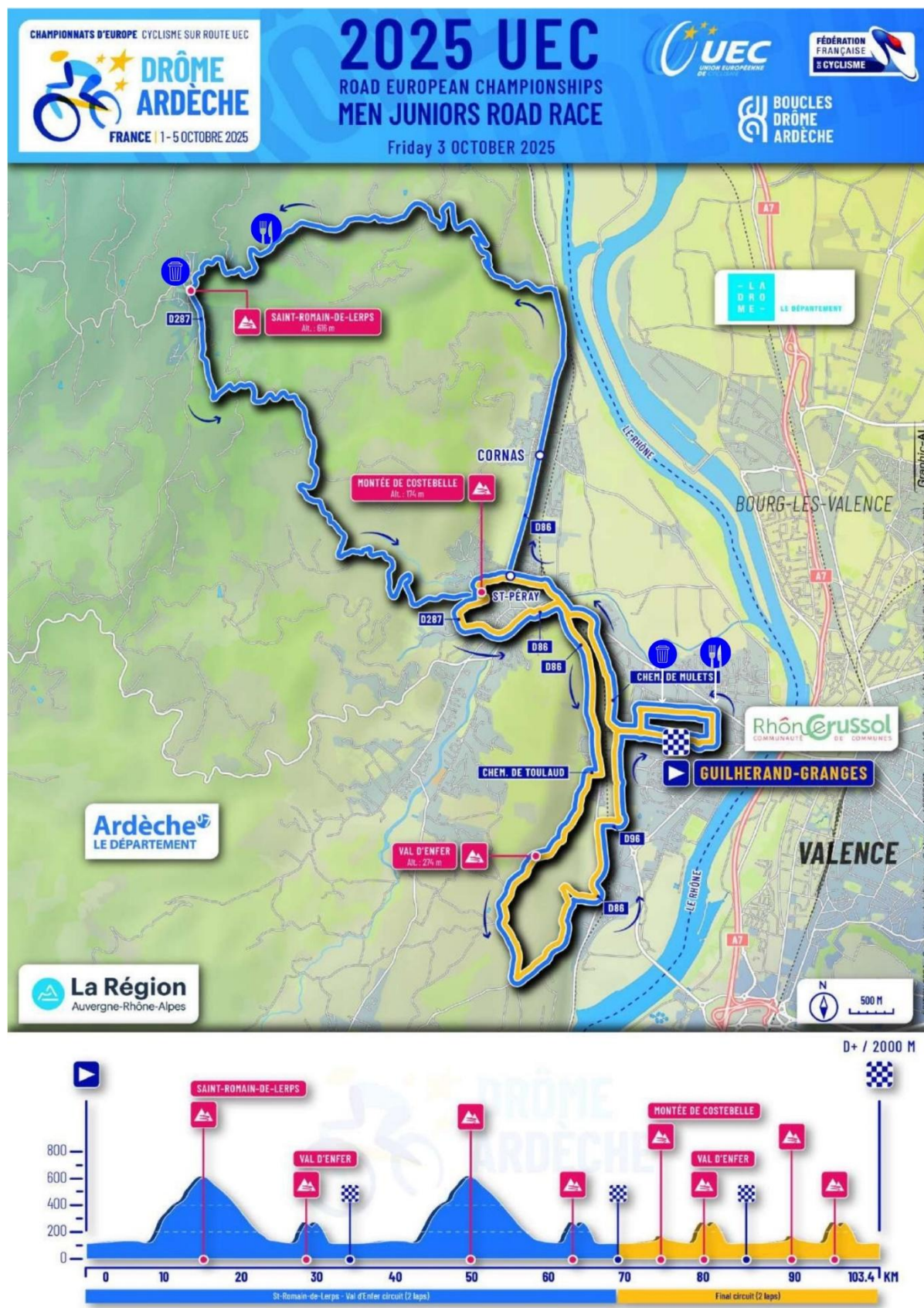

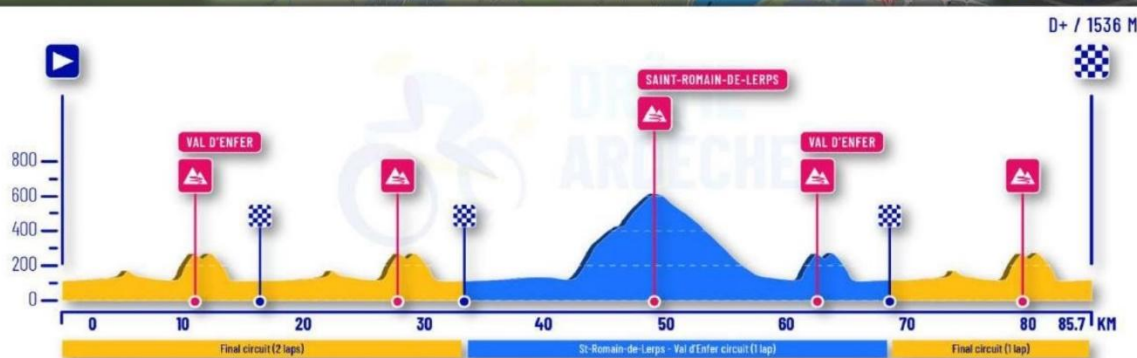

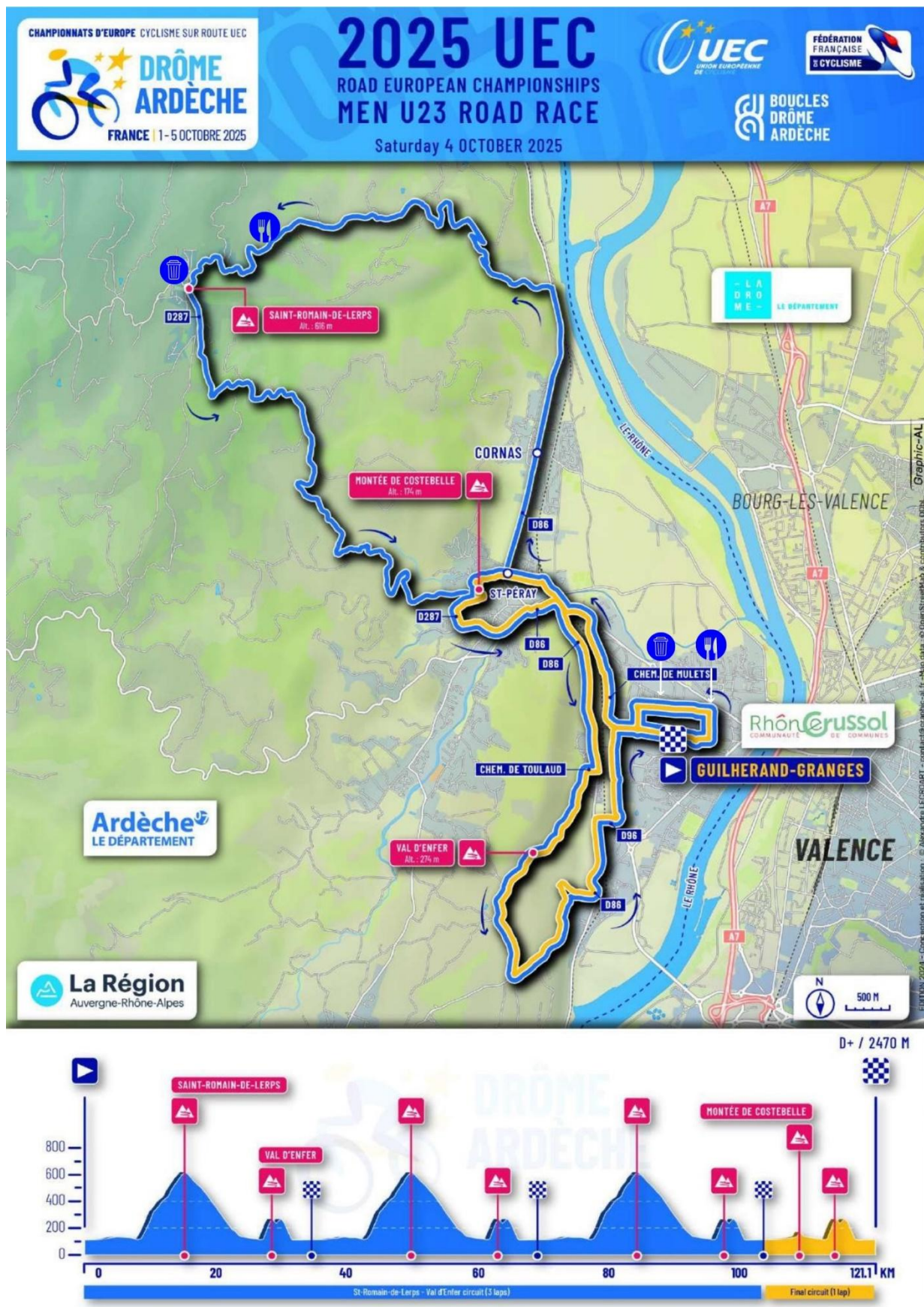

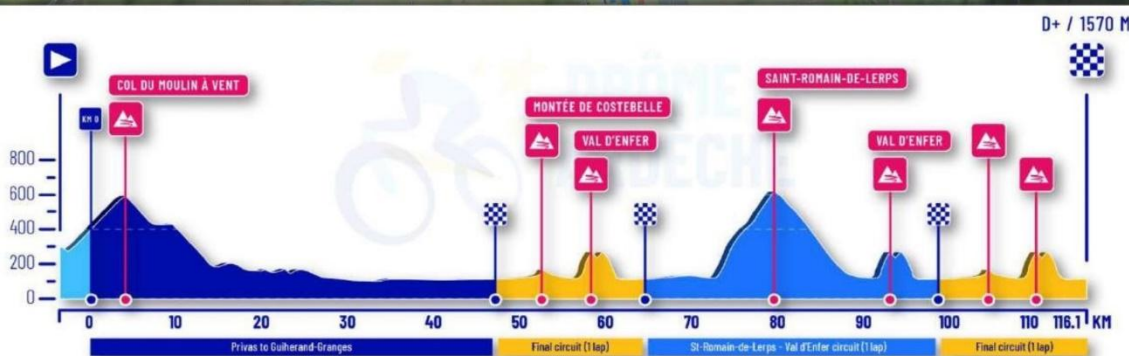

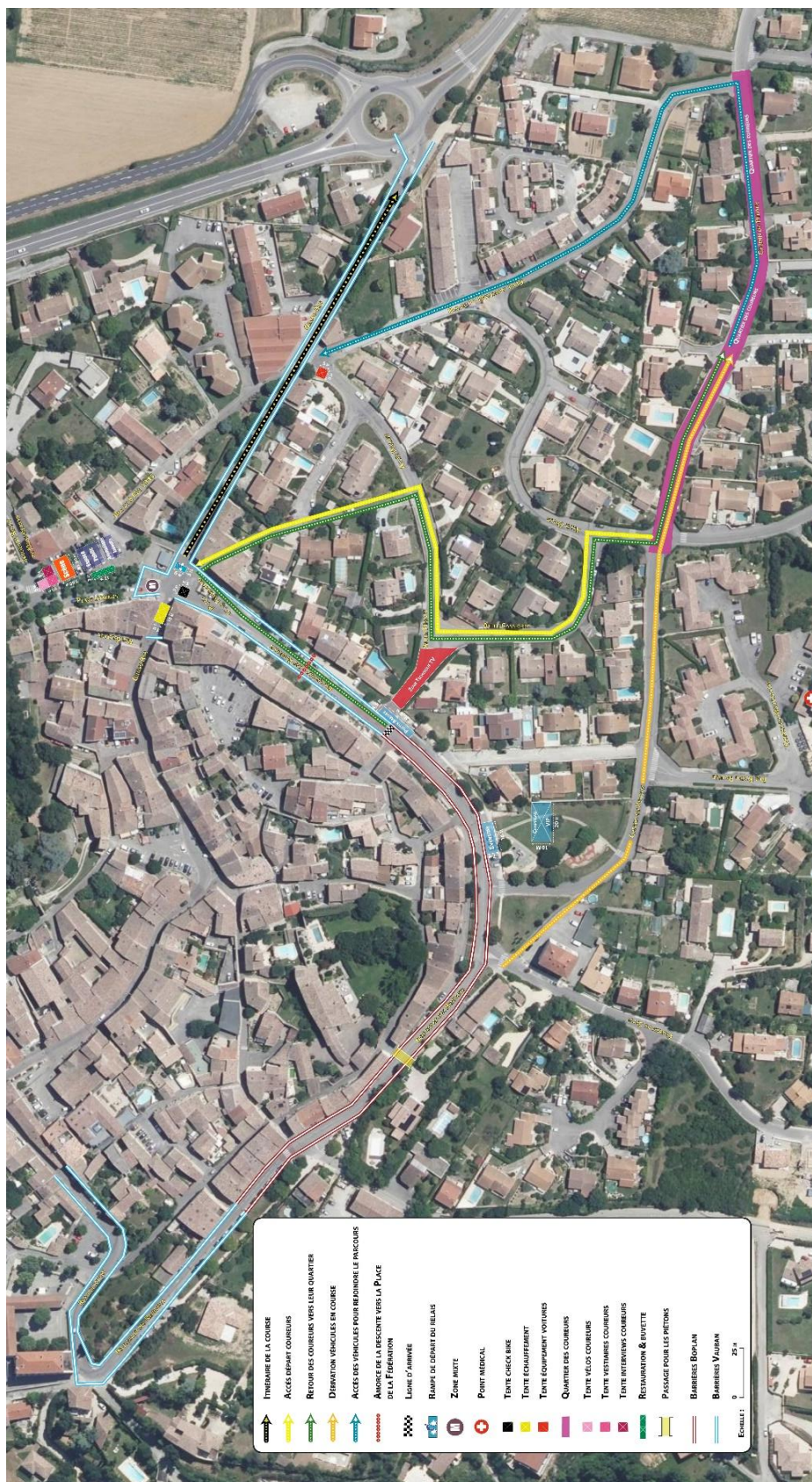

8.10. Site plan start Loriol sur Drôme (ITT)



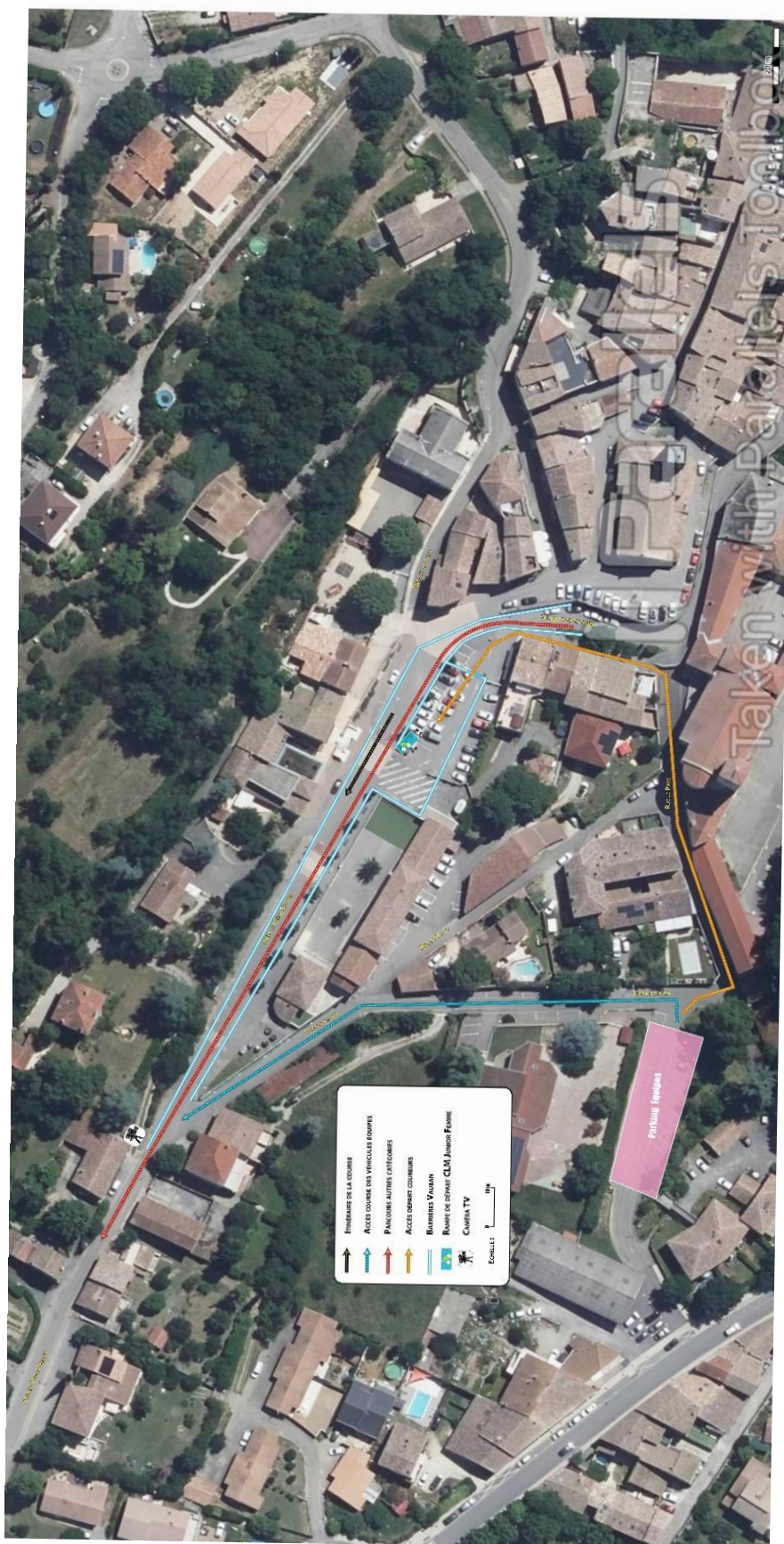
8.11. Site plan finish Etoile sur Rhône (Finish Individual Time Trial // Start and Finish Mixed Relay)
