

General:

- The 2026 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist of 12 rounds.
- All rounds count towards the final ranking.

Rounds 1 & 2: Verona (ITA)***Rounds 3 & 4: Tiel (NED)******Rounds 5 & 6: Benátky nad Jizerou (CZE)******Rounds 7 & 8: La Chapelle St. Mesmin (FRA)******Rounds 9 & 10: Sviland (NOR)******Rounds 11 & 12: Zolder (BEL)***

- All teams must register through the UEC by the deadline of 1st February 2026 to participate in the 2026 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition. The registration form is available on the website: <https://www.uec.ch>.
- The UEC BMX Commission will award prize money to the Top 3 Teams at the end of the 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organized.

Registration

- Teams wishing to participate must register a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders.
- Each team pays a registration fee of €600,- to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline: 15th February 2026).
- National teams are allowed to participate in the team ranking.
- Riders from categories 13 years and older are eligible: Challenge riders 20", Challenge Cruisers, and Championship riders.
- Minimum age for team riders is 13 years.
- Maximum 10 riders per team, but points will be awarded only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach at each event.
- If a rider competes in both 20" and 24" categories, the rider must be registered twice on the team registration form submitted before 1st February 2026.

Team confirmation

- UEC team coaches must confirm their 4 riders' participation before each event at the UEC Team confirmation, as indicated in the time schedule.
- A team manager can enter 4 riders for the first day of the competition and 4 different riders for the second day. This can only be done on Friday during UEC Team confirmation.
- If a rider is unable to race on day 2, the team manager may enter a new rider for the second day, provided this is done before the start of the heats on Day 2.

Competition

- Points are awarded according to the UEC Points Table.
- Riders earn double points for the UEC Team ranking at the last 2 rounds of the 2026 UEC BMX European Cup.
- Riders in combined categories receive ranking points based on the final result of the combined category, not the split category result.
- If a (combined or regular) category races only motos, riders receive ranking points based on the final result of that category.

Accreditation

- Each registered UEC Team receives 1 accreditation pass for the team manager per event when entering the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition.
- Accreditation for a UEC BMX team manager is valid only during the UEC BMX European Cup, not during the European Championships.
UEC Teams accreditation is valid for an event only when the team registers 4 riders for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at that event.
- Accreditation may be revoked for any breach of UEC or UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organization or the commissaires' panel.

Team manager rights

A team manager with accreditation has the following rights:

- Free entry to the track
- Free entry to staging (same rights as Chef d'Equipe)
- Free entry to the track in case of a crashed rider
- Free entry to the Team Manager meeting
- Free entry to the Team Manager area

Team area

UEC requests organizers to create a placement plan for the team area to facilitate easy movement for riders between staging, the team area, and the finish line.

Team space

A team tent space is not automatically assigned to a UEC Team. Teams must register for tent space directly with the event organizer.

- UEC Teams not entered in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as non-UEC teams.
- A UEC registered team can rent a team tent space at the event (6 x 3 m) at a cost of up to €150. Additional space (6 x 3 m) is also €150.
- Organizers may provide tent spaces for non-UEC registered teams (6 x 3 m per team) at a minimum cost of €200.
