History of TFCC De Weirijders

TFCC De Weirijders was founded in 1983 in Tiel. The club began on a small field on the Peppellaan but moved to the Hennepe in 1985 as BMX rapidly grew. When the sport became more technically demanding and gained Olympic status, this location also proved insufficient.

After a long search and successful fundraising, a new facility was built between 2017 and 2018 on the Schaarsdijkweg: Cycling Sports Center "De Betuwe." It features a modern BMX track, a 1,600-meter cycling circuit, and a cyclocross course. Since its opening in 2018, De Weirijders has grown into one of the largest and most active BMX clubs in the Netherlands.

Over the years, the club has produced many European and World Champions, including Pieter Breddels, Maartje Hereijgers, Viviana van Hees, Jaymio Brink, Dorus Brink, and Richard van Zomeren. In 2025, Richard van Zomeren became both Dutch and World Champion in the 24-inch class, while Jill Vogelpoel achieved an unprecedented six titles by becoming Dutch, European, and World Champion in both the 20-inch and 24-inch classes.

2. TRACK DETAILS

The current BMX track was constructed in 2018 by Sander Bisseling, a former member of the Dutch National BMX Team, in collaboration with Yann Bonici, Thomas Hamon, Richard van Zomeren, and Dorus Brink, whose combined expertise and experience helped shape a world-class racing facility.

Since its opening, the track has undergone several improvements and redesigns by Ewoud Stam, owner of ESSBL, ensuring that it continues to meet the highest standards of modern BMX racing.

The 5-meter starting hill, equipped with a Pro Gate starting system, launches riders into an extremely fast and dynamic opening straight. The Challenge section provides a technical yet smooth and flowing rhythm, offering both speed and precision. The Pro Section features large, demanding jumps — including a massive step-up — that truly test the skill and power of Championship-class riders. The third straight combines a variety of jumps that reward technical mastery and control, while the final section delivers a fast, flowing finish — the perfect stage for the decisive moments of countless thrilling finals.



3. THE CITY OF TIEL

Tiel is one of the ten oldest cities in the Netherlands, centrally located in the heart of the Betuwe region — an area renowned for its delicious fruit and scenic landscapes. The city's cheerful mascot, Flipje, a fruit character, reflects this rich local heritage.

Visitors can enjoy exploring Tiel's historic city centre, with its charming shopping streets that evoke the atmosphere of the Hanseatic period. The city offers a pleasant mix of boutique shops, restaurants, and cafés, along with beautiful parks and city gardens that invite you to relax and unwind.


By car

- To register for UEC events you need an account using your UCI-ID.
- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly.
- *Administration fee depends on the agreements with the organizer.
- **If applicable, National Federation fee.
- ***Bank costs depend on your payment choice and will be charged directly.
- After registration you receive a confirmation e-mail from JSTiming.
- In this portal you can find the most current registration overview at the event under the 'Entries' button.
- Cancellation costs and administration/bank costs depend on the agreements with the organizer.
- After cancellation you receive an e-mail confirming your cancellation from JSTiming.
- Refund [if applicable] will follow the deadline for cancellations.

Late entries

Late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for late entries, paying double entry fee.
The deadline for late entries can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

Extra late entries

Extra late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for extra late entries, paying triple entry fee.
The deadline for extra late entries can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.
In case of a cancellation before the deadline, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per round) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

In case of a cancellation after the deadline, the entry fee will NOT be refunded.

Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

Transponders

All riders in Challenge 15/16 and Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager.

Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race.

If a rider fails to return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100 per transponder to the federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next UEC BMX European Cup round until the invoice is paid.

Above apply both for all races of the UEC BMX European Cup.

11. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Riders' categories: as set forth in chapter 9 'Rider categories'.
- UEC BMX European Cup events are open to all riders who are licensed by a National Federation, with a minimum age of 8 years old. There is no limit in the number of riders a country can register.
- Event format Challenge categories: For all Challenge categories, excluded Boys 15/16 & Girls 15/16, scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event of the UEC BMX European Cup events.
- Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Event format Challenge category Boys 15/16, Girls 15/16 and Championship categories:

- The UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to articles 6.3.009 till 6.3.014 of the latest version of the [UCI BMX Rulebook \(link to UCI website\)](#).
- Riders are not automatically entered in both Rounds of each UEC BMX European Cup event. Riders can opt to participate in only 1 Round during the UEC BMX European Cup event.
- All riders in Championships categories and Challenge 15/16 require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Cup Rounds. The rider is responsible to have the assigned transponder correctly attached to the bike at all times during warmup, practice and racing.
- Seeding on day 1: the latest UCI individual ranking. seeding on day 2: the result of the first day. In case of a combined classes: first all the Elite ranked riders are seeded, second all the U23 ranked riders. The unranked riders follow randomly.
- Gate starting positions are decided as follows:
 - a. Round 1: With each heat, gate positions are chosen in the order in which the riders are seeded.
 - b. Last Chance: Within each heat, gate positions are chosen in order of the riders' lap time from Round 1 (fastest to slowest).
 - c. Qualifiers and Finals: In order of lap time (fastest to slowest) from the preceding phase or round.For the first round of the Qualifiers, the seeding order of the first round of the Qualifiers is used. Ties are broken by lap time from the phase or round before, until the tie is broken (up to and including seeding order in Round 1).

Rider's equipment:

- All Challenge riders (including 15/16 riders) must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.
- All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.
- The current leader in the UEC BMX European Cup is racing with a red leader plate. Only applicable for the categories Boys 15/16; Girls 15/16; Junior Men; Junior Women, Men U23; Women U23; Men Elite; Women Elite.
- If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:
 - the jersey awarded by the federation,
 - a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
 - their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country.

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be on Thursday, as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be the Welcome Centre. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

12. ACCREDITATION

Prior to each event, it is mandatory for every national federation to register their staff. Federations are required to submit the names and the roles of all staff members via email to j.polkamp@uec.ch in advance of the event.

A Chef d'Equipe or his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Athletes

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

National Teams

Prior to each event, it is mandatory for every national federation to register their National team staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members). Federations are required to submit the names and the roles of all staff members via email to j.polkamp@uec.ch one week in advance of the event.

Chef d'Equipe

Each federation that pre-registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list at rider confirmation, as indicated in the timing schedule.

Mandatory registration of staff before the event

Prior to each event, it is mandatory for every national federation to register their appointed Chef d'Equipe as well as the entire team. Federations are required to submit the names of all staff members via email to j.polkamp@uec.ch one week in advance of the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license issued by the federation. The UEC will verify the registration details of all staff members before granting accreditation. Please note that accreditation will not be issued by the UEC in the absence of proper registration.

National BMX coaches

UEC acknowledges official BMX National coaches for European Cup. National federations can register their coaches. They will be provided with accreditation per race. A country can register max 2 coaches per country per race.

Personal BMX coaches for Championship riders

Championships riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach are offered the possibility to buy a Coach accreditation. This accreditation (for Championships riders only) costs €150 per weekend. This allows you access to the team manager meeting and coach area. This coach accreditation can be bought from UEC Technical coordinator at the Welcome Centre during rider confirmation.

13. 2026 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING & TEAM AREA

No cars, electric steps or other motorized vehicles will be admitted to the Team area or event venue. For all rules concerning UEC BMX European Cup Team Ranking see European Cup Team Rules document on UEC website (www.uec.ch/en/BMX-european-cup).

UEC Registered teams

Prior to each event, UEC teams must confirm the participation of their four riders during the designated rider confirmation process, as outlined in the event schedule. After the first moto begins, the confirmed rider list cannot be changed or supplemented. These four designated riders will gain points for the UEC BMX Team ranking.

Once the four riders for the Team ranking have been confirmed, the team manager will receive accreditation for the event. Accreditation is granted exclusively to teams that enter the team competition. The UEC BMX team manager or an appointed assistant receives accreditation, providing access to the restricted areas required to fulfill their responsibilities.

Accreditation may be withdrawn if there is any violation of UEC or UCI regulations, or failure to comply with instructions from the organizers or the commissaires' panel.

For all rules concerning UEC BMX European Cup Team Ranking see European Cup Team Rules document on UEC website (www.uec.ch/en/bmx-european-cup).

Team parking

Team parking will be available at the track for team managers.

A parking permit is included in the envelope that you receive when registering your team tent reservation at the Welcome Centre (club building). This envelope also contains a map showing the location of the team tent, an access wristband, the parking permit, and a rubbish bag.

Accreditation team manager

Teams only receive accreditation when they enter the team competition at the event. A UEC BMX team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI regulations or non-compliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team Spaces for UEC registered teams

UEC Teams must register team spaces as indicated in the event Technical Guide. The organiser will provide spaces for team tents to UEC registered teams, or 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €150 per team space. This includes 1x free event entry ticket (pass-partout) per team tent space paid for. It is possible to buy additional space of 6 x 3 m at the same price (€150).

If your team tent is 8 x 4 m you need to reserve the space of 8 x 4 m for UEC registered teams at the cost of €250.

It is also possible to rent a tent (6 x 3 m) at a rate of €200 (excl. team tent space and subject to availability).

Team Spaces for other teams

The organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €200. These teams receive 1 free event ticket (pass-partout) from the organizer per team tent (6x3m). It is possible to buy additional space of 6 x 3 m at the same price (€200).

If your team tent is 8 x 4 m you need to reserve the space of 8 x 4 m for non-UEC registered teams at the cost of €300.

It is also possible to rent a tent (6 x 3 m) at a rate of €200 (excl. team tent space and subject to availability).

Prize money Championship classes

You will receive a price ticket after finishing or at the prize ceremony. Please provide your name, IBAN code and BIC code on this ticket. When filled in, take your ticket + ID and go to the club building, contact person: Patrick Goossens. The prize money will be paid immediately to the riders by bank transfer.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Prize money (per round)

The prize money will be increased by 10% with more than 1.000 participants registered per day.

17. CAMPING

Camping site must be cleared before Monday 6th of April 20h00. Camping spots include free showers, toilets and water facility at the showers. Electricity is not available.

Check-in: Arrival is possible on Thursday 2nd of April or Friday 3rd of April. Please select your arrival day + time block of arrival during the reservation.

Departure: Camping site must be cleared before Monday 6th of April 20h00.

The camping prices are by reservations before 15th of February:

- Caravan with max. length 6 meters €125
- Caravan larger than 6 meters €150
- Camper with max. length 6,5 meters €125
- Camper larger than 6,5 meters and with a max. length of 9 meters €150

When making a reservation after the 15th of February you will be charged an extra €25

20. PARKING

At walking distance there is free parking available for riders, visitors and teams. Please follow the signing and instructions of the crew.

Disabled parking spaces and a limited number of free parking spaces are located next to the track for staff and crew members, officials, and Team Managers.

This parking is clearly indicated and the car must be provided with a parking card. You will receive the parking card after the registration of your license plate number via the club.

21. CATERING

There will be several catering stands, where you can buy hot and cold food and drinks.

22. SHOPS

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Cup. All places are fully booked. The BMX village/shop must be cleared before Monday 6th of April 20h00.

23. PRESS

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

During the UEC BMX European Cup events accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC. It is mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC official.
- During the events, five red Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: €20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

Drones

- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

24. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room at the bottom of the start ramp.
