7. EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The 2026 UEC Deryn & Stayers European Championship will be organized by the Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with **ASD AMICI DELLA PISTA**.
- 1.2** It will be held in accordance with the regulations and guidelines of the UCI & the UEC. Bicycles and motorcycles must be in accordance with UCI regulations, with the exception of the rules in Article 4.
- With the registration to the UEC Deryn & Stayer European Championships all participants accept the special regulations in any point.
- These Championships may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team.
- 1.3** **Body numbers – Clothes**
- The riders are obliged to use the body-numbers which will be supplied by the organization. Changes to these body-numbers and clothes are not allowed. Riders must compete in their national jersey.
- Pacer suit**
- Pacer suits will be provided by the organizer.
- 1.4** **Unforeseen**
- In those events in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC technical delegate and the organisation (where applicable), will decide.

ARTICLE 2. RIDERS AND PACERS – REGISTRATION

Up to 6 riders and pacers may be nominated with 4 of these riders and pacers to contest the championship. Riders and pacers will be nominated by the National Federation of the rider. Riders may only use pacers from another nationality if the agreement of the pacer's National Federation has been obtained. Pacers may only pace one rider per category in the championship meaning maximum 3 races per day. Pacers shall hold a licence and shall not be aged older than 65 years old. It is the responsibility of the national federation to verify that the pacer has a medical certificate required to participate in international competitions.

ARTICLE 3. BIKES CHECK

Stayer : All bikes will be checked by the Jury on Saturday 18 July at 13:30 at the venue.
Gear limitations max. 9,54 m (67 x 15).

Deryn : The gear ratio will not be limited.

ARTICLE 4. MOTORBIKES ENGINE

Stayer

Motors (Engines) / Pace machines are provided by the organizer.
The motors are allocated at the team managers & pacers meeting by drawing.

Derny

Motors (Engines) / Pace machines / Pacers Derny's are not provided by the organizer.
It is necessary to bring and use your own Derny machine.

Exceptions UCI rules :

3.6.042 The height of the rear of the saddle above the ground shall be 820 mm minimum.

3.6.043 The handlebar shall be made in one piece and be a maximum 550 mm across (distance measured at the extremities of the grips).

ARTICLE 5. BIKES TECHNICAL STANDARDS FOR STAYER

Front wheel diameter "24" or "600" with radius or batons no disc.

Rear wheel diameter "28" or "700" with radius or batons or disc.

Distance between front wheel axis and boxes bottom bracket axis 55 cm mandatory.

Front of the saddle at the top of bottom bracket axis no in front mandatory.

Saddle with lumbar support prohibited.

Tilt 9 degrees maximum for the saddle mandatory.

Solid and expandable reinforcement rod between the fork head and the end of the galls mandatory.

Solid and expandable reinforcement rod recommended between the saddle and the horizontal tube.

Pneumatics well glued and securely secured by a single-length glued canvas of 4 cm minimum height.

The fork must be bent backwards to get a negative hunt.

ARTICLE 6. AWARDS – PRIZE MONEY

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded for riders and pacers:

The 1st place: Champion(s) jersey and Gold medal

The 2nd place: Silver medal

The 3rd place: Bronze medal

Winners are obliged to be in time for the awards ceremony.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey and shall not wear a helmet, a cap a headband or glasses until they leave the podium ceremony area.

The prize money will be paid through your federation by mid-November.

ARTICLE 7. ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.
The antidoping tests will take place at the Velodrome Antidoping Station.
The anti-doping controls will be under the responsibility of ITA/UCI.

ARTICLE 8. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 9. RESPONSIBILITIES

The Organiser and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The Organiser and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
