All National Federations have to present themselves at the time of confirmation of the riders to ensure the participation of their riders. The collection of the badge for a passenger cannot be considered as a confirmation of their participation.

Observations

- At the time of confirmation of the riders, the Team Managers of the National Teams must present their national team to the stewards.
- The bibs must be collected at the time indicated in the Championship program. Riders' licenses and passports must be submitted to the Stewards Panel.
- The Rider will ensure that their identification number is visible and legible at all times. The identification number must be properly fixed and may not be bent or altered.
- Please note that training will not be authorized without a license plate.

8. SPECIFIC REGULATIONS OF THE RACE

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The 2026 UEC MTB Marathon European Championships are organized by the Ramales Mountain Bike Club in collaboration with the Union Européenne de Cyclisme (UEC).

Race Director (DOF): Fernando San Emeterio Gandiaga

- 1.2** The event will be organized according to the rules of the International Cycling Union (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.
- 1.3** The UEC MTB Marathon European Championships consist of the following races:
✓ **MTB Marathon (XCM) on 12 July 2026.**

ARTICLE 2. – TYPE OF EVENT

- 2.1** The event is open to athletes in the following categories:

- ✓ **MTB Marathon Elite Men**
- ✓ **MTB Marathon Elite Women**
- ✓ **MTB Marathon Masters Hombre**
Aged: 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 / 50-54 / 55-59 / 60-64 / 65-69 / 70-74 / 75+
- ✓ **MTB Women's Masters Marathon**
Age: 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 / 50-54 / 55-59 / 60+

- 2.2** It is entered on the UCI calendar as a Continental Championships (CC) and Continental Masters Championships (CCM) event

2.3 The following final classifications will be produced for:

- ✓ **Men's Elite***
- ✓ **Women's Elite***
- ✓ **All Masters categories ***

**The 3 best riders in each category must attend the official awards ceremony.*

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

3.1 National Teams

⇒ Elite only

National Federations can register the following riders for the Championships **for free**:

- ✓ **Elite Women – max. 2 riders**
- ✓ **Elite Men – max. 2 riders**

If the national teams have more than 2 riders (WE/ME), point 3.2 below applies = must be registered.

Deadline for registration: Sunday, 5 July 2026 (23:59 CET)

Registration applies to riders, staff and official of the NF delegates.

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

3.2 Other cyclists

⇒ ELITE individuals (non-members of the "National Team")

⇒ MASTERS *

In accordance with the UCI regulations, the participation is open exclusively to riders holding a European sporting nationality with an annual licence issued by a National Federation affiliated to the UCI.

In the event of dual nationality, the sporting nationality shall be the one recorded in the UCI Data Ride system, which shall be deemed authoritative and binding for all regulatory and eligibility purposes.

** The attention of all participants registered in the MASTERS categories is drawn to the importance, before registration and also before presenting themselves at the license control, of checking that they meet the requirements defined by the UCI to participate in events of the UCI international masters calendar"*

** 4.1.009 All cyclists aged 35 and over who hold a master's licence can take part in mountain bike events on the UCI International Masters Calendar, except:*

- 1. riders who, during the current season starting on 1 January, have scored 1 or more UCI points during the same calendar year as a UCI Masters event;*
- 2. riders who during the current year have been members of a team registered with the UCI. (text amended on 1.01.18; 1.01.20, 1.01.21)*

3.3 Start order

The starting order will be made in accordance with UCI/UEC regulations.

The riders line up in the order in which they are to be called to the start line.

The number of riders on each line is decided by the President of the Commissaires' panel and supervised by the commissaires. The rider himself decides which position on the line to take.

3.4 Starting grid**⇒ ELITE RIDERS**

The start grid will be determined in accordance with article 4.02.061 of the UCI MTB Regulations as follows:

1. according to the latest UCI XCM individual ranking published
2. according to the latest UCI XCO individual ranking published
3. Unclassified riders: by draw

3.5 Starting grid**⇒ MASTER RIDERS**

The start order for all Masters categories will be as follows:

1. 2025 defending European champion of the categories concerned, younger categories first
2. according to the order of the online registration

ARTICLE 4. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

The following UCI Regulations will apply:

- 4.2.038 Staff working for riders must wear easily identifiable team clothing.
- 4.2.040 For the Olympic Games, world championships, world cup events and continental championships nobody may enter a feed/technical assistance zone without accreditation.
- For world cup events season long accreditations issued to the UCI ELITE MTB TEAMS and UCI MTB TEAMS by the UCI. For the national federations or individual riders passes are prepared by the organiser and handed out at registration: they obtain 1 accreditation per registered rider per zone. Note that for a double feed/technical assistance zone they only obtain 1 accreditation per registered rider.
- 4.2.042 The spraying of water on riders or bicycles by the feeders or mechanics is forbidden. High pressure washers are forbidden in the Feed/Technical Assistance zone.
(text modified on 1.01.26)
- 4.2.044 No rider may turn back on the course to reach a feed/technical assistance zone. Any rider doing so is disqualified.
Only within the feed/technical assistance zone itself, a rider may turn back without obstructing other competitors. Only within the feed/service zone, a rider can back up without obstructing other competitors.
- 4.2.045 Technical assistance during a race is permitted subject to the conditions below.
- 4.2.046 Authorised technical assistance during a race consists of repairs to or the replacement of any part of the bicycle other than the frame.
Bike changes are not permitted, and the rider must cross the finishing line with the same handlebar number plate that he/she had at the start.
- 4.2.047 Technical assistance can only be given in the feed/technical assistance zones.
- 4.2.048 Spare equipment and tools for repairs must be kept in these zones. Repairs and equipment changes can be carried out by the rider himself or with the help of a teammate, team mechanic or neutral technical assistance.
- 4.2.049 In addition to technical assistance in feed zones, technical assistance is permitted outside these zones only between riders who are members of the same UCI ELITE MTB team, UCI MTB team or of the same national team / nation.
Riders may carry tools and spare parts as long as they do not pose any danger to the rider himself or to the other competitors.

ARTICLE 5. AWARDS CEREMONIES

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the top 3 riders in each category must attend the official awards ceremony, the organized interviews and the press conference. Unless otherwise stated, riders must appear at official ceremonies in competition clothing.

5.1 **Jersey and medals**

Each European Championship will be awarded with:

1st place: Gold medal and champion's jersey
2nd place: Silver Medal
3rd place: Bronze medal

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 8. RESPONSIBILITIES

The organizer and UEC will not, in any case, be responsible for any accident or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organiser and UEC decline all responsibility towards cyclists and other people in the event of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, UCI rules will apply. Any issues will be resolved between the organizers, the Panel of Commissioners, and UEC officials.

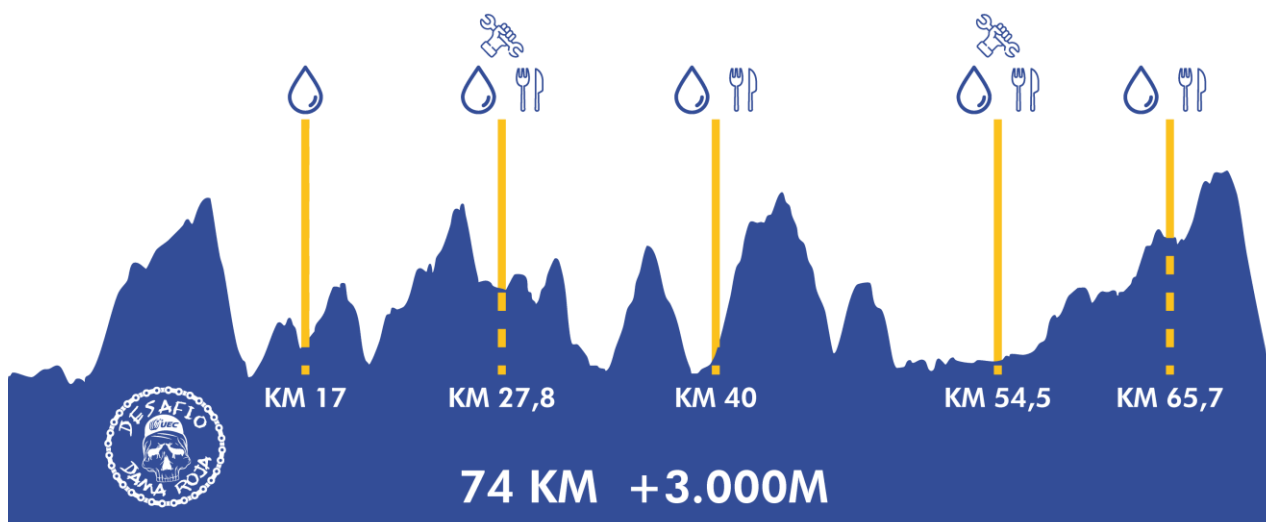
