3.3. CONFIRMATION OF STARTERS / LICENSE CHECK

Team managers must confirm all starters, presenting all licenses (with passport or copy for the Juniors category) and provide a sample of teams' apparel. Moreover, in order to accelerate the preparation of the start lists we would be grateful if each nation could provide us a list with the best time/result realized of their riders in timed events.

To assist the National Federations with the final confirmation, an online tool has been created: the UEC Events Check-In System. This will give coaches and team managers the opportunity to upload information on starters in each event remotely in a 2-day window immediately prior to final confirmation and license check. 3.4. TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

Riders' numbers will be distributed during that meeting. We request a maximum representation of two people per team attend the meeting.

Attendance is required by UCI and National Commissaires, Team Managers, Event Director, UEC Track Coordinator, UEC representative, UEC Events coordinator, UEC Technical coordinator and UEC Chef de Piste.

3.5. TEAM PARKING AREA

Teams should park in the designated spaces around the Velodrome.



3.6. TEAM STORAGE AREA

Each team is allocated a space in the storage areas, velodrome inside.

These areas are provided with lighting and covered with security 24 hours a day starting from Saturday, 4 July.

Teams who arrive prior should contact the velodrome, through the email info@rsc-cottbus.de to see if further arrangements can be made at teams' costs.

The Organiser will meet each team on arrival and show the designated space.

Teams should bring their own lockers because as this common area will be shared with other teams.

Teams will be able to access the storage areas from **Saturday, 4 July 13:00** until **Sunday, 12 July 20:00**.

3.7. TEAM BOXES (infield)

Team boxes will be available from Friday, 3 July at 13:00. Team boxes are allocated in the track centre taking into account the size of each team. Due to the large number of people on the track centre, the space is limited. Please ensure equipment does not excessively narrow or block walkways.

Team boxes will have one table, chairs and bike racks. No furniture is allowed to be removed from the allocated box, from the infield or chained up.

Power supply in team boxes

Teams boxes will be powered with 230V, standard 2-pin outlet. The venue requires that all electrical equipment meets German Standards and Safety requirements. Teams must have all appliances tested and tagged by a qualified electrician.

Please do not plug extension leads into this socket or kettles, coffee machines or fan heaters as they use high power consumption and may cause the supply to fail.

3.8. TEAMS CHANGING ROOMS

There are male / female changing rooms and shower facilities available at the velodrome.

3.9. RIDING BICYCLES IN THE VENUE

Riding bicycles in the corridors of the velodrome is prohibited at all times. Bicycles are only to be ridden within the warm up zone and on the track.

Tunnel safety measures:

- The tunnel must remain free of obstacles.
- Are **NOT** allowed in the tunnel:
 - o Cycling
 - o Standing starts
 - o Rollers

3.10. TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

An area will be provided for sports scientists on the home straight concourse. Availability is limited. All NF wishing to utilize this facility must book their position with the Organiser, prior to their arrival and **no later than Monday 15 June 2026.**

The cost of this service (price to be confirmed on booking request)* will need to be borne by the teams. Bookings will be made on a first come, first served basis.

Please note: Price will vary depending on the request and the provider doing the service. NF will not be able to set up their own wireless networks as they interfere with other equipment in use by LOC. All those private set ups will be immediately removed by the LOC.

4. MEDIA

The Main Media Area is located in the infield the track. In the infield: extra tent next to the storage areas. In order to access the Media Area an accreditation is necessary.

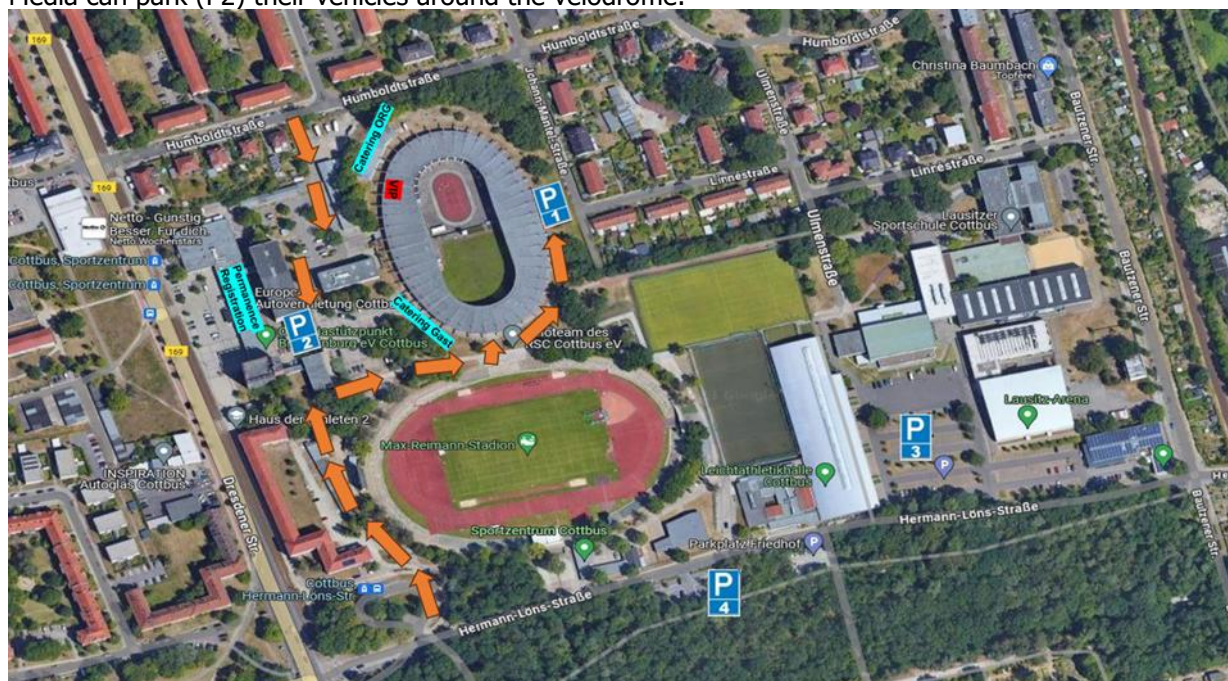

5.1.2. Open training & Warm-up sessions during the competition

- Training behind a deryn or motorbike is prohibited during any of the sessions.
- Using the starting blocks is not permitted during any of the sessions.
- Standing starts are only permitted during warm-up sessions only, under the following conditions :
 - on the home straight only
 - with the assistance of someone waving a flag at the exit of the 4th bend to warn the other riders present on the track
 - in the last 15' during the warm-up sessions prior to team sprint or kilometre events
 - with the approval of the UEC Chef de Piste and/or commissaires overseeing the training sessions.
- Madison exchanges will only be allowed during the Madison training sessions

a. Every competition day in the morning

- Venue will open 2:00 hours before the competition start.
- Warm-up will start 1h30' before the competition start only for competition riders of the day.
- End of warm-up 15 minutes before the competition start.

b. Between session 1 and session 2

- After end of session 1: start open training if possible.
- Last 45' before start of session 2: warm-up only for competition riders of the 2nd session.
- 15' before start of session 2: end of warm-up

6.1. ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with the Radsportclub Cottbus E.V. will organise the 2026 Track Juniors and U23 European Championships for the following disciplines.

Entrants for European Championships shall hold licenses issued by a Federation affiliated to the UEC and have the nationality of the Federation submitting the entry.

Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit, qualification heats will be added to the competition schedule.

1.4 The riders to contest each Championship shall be confirmed by an official of their Federation to the Commissaires, during the confirmation procedure, before the start of the Team Managers meeting.

1.5 Riders ages shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules.

Nevertheless, taking into account the UCI rules, articles 1.1.034, 3.2.001, 3.4.004, 9.2.024, 11.1.003 and in accordance with the UCI, the participation at the U23 competitions shall be open to riders of 18 and over.

According to the UCI Track Regulations art. 3.2.001, only 2nd year juniors are allowed to participate in individual events of the U23 category.

Therefore, a Junior rider who decides to compete in an individual event of the U23 category have to announce his/her choice at the license check control and this choice will be valid for all events of the European Championships.

This rider won't be allowed to compete in Junior Individual and Team events.

TEAM EVENTS

Riders in the Junior category may also contest Under 23 Championships provided that:

- ✓ Men & Women Under 23 Team Pursuit: maximum 2 junior riders per team
- ✓ Men & Women Under 23 Team Sprint: maximum 1 junior rider per team
- ✓ Men & Women Under 23 Madison: maximum 1 junior rider per team

However, in team competitions, juniors are only permitted to participate in only one category of the team event in which they are competing.

Examples:

- A junior competing in the U23 Team Pursuit is not allowed to participate in the Junior Team Pursuit but may contest the Junior Madison
- A junior competing in the U23 Madison, is not allowed to participate in the Junior Madison but may contest the Junior Team Pursuit

Riders who are Under 23 but registered as a member of a road trade team (World Teams, Women's World Teams, Pro Teams, Continental Teams, Women's Continental Teams) may contest the Under 23 championships.

1.6 Body numbers – Clothes

The riders are obliged to use the body numbers which will be supplied by the organization. Changes to these body numbers and clothes are not allowed. Riders must compete in their national jersey.

Riders shall wear one (1) body number in the following events:

1km TT, Individual Pursuit, Team Pursuit (each rider one number), Team Sprint (each rider one number).

Riders shall wear two (2) body numbers in all other races, Omnium included.

The riders competing in Madison will receive dedicated body numbers.

Pin less number systems:

- Bunch events : numbers must be placed on outer layer of clothing
- Individual Pursuit / TT Km / Team Pursuit / Team Sprint : number pockets permitted

1.7 Publication

All results, rankings and communiqués will be available in in teams announcement boards. Results will also be published on the UEC website: www.uec.ch and on the official live timing website: www.veloresults.com

1.8 Unforeseen

In those events in which the regulations not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC Technical delegate and the organization (where applicable), will decide.

- 1.9 As per UCI regulation 1.3.023, any rider of height 1.80m and taller, who wishes to apply for height exemption for handlebar extensions, must submit a "Rider Attestation Application" form to the UCI 15 days prior the competition, so as to appear on the "UCI Official List of Riders in Category 2 & 3 Height" document. No rider height measurements will be performed at the championships.

6.2. ARTICLE 2 - EVENTS REGULATIONS

2.1 Sprint, Individual Pursuit, 1km TT, Points Races, Keirin, Scratch, Team Pursuit, Team Sprint, Omnium, Madison.

All the above-mentioned Championships will be conducted in accordance with the UCI-regulations, subject to any exemptions approved by the UCI.

- 2.2 Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit, all riders entered shall first participate in qualifying heats according to the UCI Regulations, except Elimination Juniors (see 6.2.3).

The maximum number of the riders/teams on the track will be determined by the UEC Track Commission.

2.3 Elimination race (as a Championship)

1. For the start of the race, riders shall line up in single file along the railing and in the sprinters lane.
2. The coaches holding their rider in the sprinters lane are followed to push them during the start but from a standstill position (2 feet on the ground at the same time).
3. Where applicable, the order of the riders shall be determined according to the UCI regulations, in respect to their current UCI Individual Track Endurance Classification.

The order for non-ranked riders, will be done by drawing lots.

Team managers are reminded to collect their LED devises next to the race secretariat/timing platform, at least 30 min. before each Elimination race.

Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit, all riders entered shall first participate in qualifying heats according to the UCI Regulations. Except for the Junior category where in the interest of their development, qualifications will not be run by a scratch race but by an elimination race. A minimum of 2 riders must be eliminated, and the result of the qualifications determines the starting order in the final.

The maximum number of the riders/teams on the track will be determined by the UEC Track Commission.

2.4 Madison

1. One (1) team from each nation may contest each Championship.

2. The distances for each championship are:

Women Junior	20 km
Men Junior	30 km
Women U23	25 km
Men Under 23	40 km

In case of qualifying heats, the distance shall be 50% of the distance of the final.

3. The UEC Track Commission shall consider the experience of riders in the Junior Championships in deciding the number of riders to contest the final.

4. The maximum number of the riders/teams on the track will be determined by the UEC Track Commission

6.3. ARTICLE 3 - AWARDS

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded for:

The 1st place: Champion(s) jersey and Gold medal

The 2nd place: Silver medal

The 3rd place: Bronze medal

For team pursuit and team sprint, medals and jerseys will be awarded to all riders of the three teams on the podium. To receive the medal/jersey, the rider must have participated in the competition.

Winners are obliged to be in time for the awards ceremony.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey and shall not wear a helmet, a cap a headband or glasses until they leave the podium ceremony area.



6.4. ARTICLE 4 - ANTIDOPING

The event may be selected for doping controls either by the International Testing Agency (ITA) or by the National Antidoping Agency. If selected, doping controls will be conducted under the UCI Anti-Doping Rules.

The antidoping tests will take place in the office of the Olympic base in the sport centre.



6.5. ARTICLE 5 - PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

6.6. ARTICLE 6 - RESPONSABILITIES

The Organiser and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The Organiser and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
