CHECK-IN SYSTEM - CONFIRMATION OF STARTERS - LICENCE CHECK

UEC Events Check-In System.

To assist the National Federations with the registration and final confirmation of riders, an online tool has been created: the UEC Events Check-In System.

This will give NF coaches and team managers the opportunity to upload information on starters in each event remotely in a **2-day window** immediately prior to final confirmation and licence check. During this check-in window, changes can be made at any time allowing flexibility for NFs in case of illness, injuries or other factors.

Registration and final confirmation will remain exactly as before, but the new system will reduce the time required for final confirmation by allowing NF coaches and managers to upload information remotely. Attached are the information and guide for this new system.

The check-in system will open on Friday, 3 July at 13:00 CET. You can log in using the following link:

Once the team manager has confirmed all starters during the “Riders confirmation and licence Check” on **Monday 6 July** the system will mark the event as closed.

- the riders' licences (with passport or copy for the Juniors category)
- the team's jersey and short or skinsuit
- the address of the hotel or accommodation of the national team
