Race Doctors and paramedics will be appointed by Konya PDH.

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present onsite throughout official training sessions and competitions. The medical team will be based in the track center during official training and racing days. A Central Medical Station will be located on the ground floor, in close proximity to infield and the ambulance entrance ramp.

Outside official training and competition sessions, emergency medical care is available through the national public health for medical care. They are contacted in an emergency by dialing 112.

VENUE EVACUATION

In the event that an evacuation of the building is required, please follow the instructions of the security and stewarding personnel. Please exit the building calmly and quickly.

RIDERS SAFETY ON THE ROADS

2.8. MAP PARKING AREA, etc.

Accreditations and Vehicle Parking Pass should be picked up at Accreditation center at the Spectators' Entrance.

Teams and accredited media must use the designated parking space in Velodrome area to ensure efficient parking arrangements.

The reserved parking lot can be easily located by following the signs labeled "Teams".

Upon arrival, teams can access Athlete's Entrance for team storages.

3.1. ACCREDITATION

Accreditations can be collected starting from 30 January, at the accreditation center located at **the Konya Velodrome** during opening hours.

Please ensure that you collect your accreditation as soon as you arrive as it will be required to access to all parts of the venue.

3.6. TEAM PARKING AREA

On-site parking is limited. Teams with less than 6 riders will receive one (1) vehicle parking pass and others will receive two (2). The parking pass must be always visible in the parked vehicle. Parking passes can be picked up at the accreditation centre.

3.7. TEAMS STORAGE AREA

Teams can access the storage compound from **14:00 on Thursday, January 29th, until 23:00 on Thursday, February 5th**. The Team Cabin Coordinator will meet each team upon arrival and lead them to their designated cabin. It is crucial that teams only use the cabin assigned to them, as some smaller teams may have to share cabins due to space constraints and the number of teams entered.

A security deposit of €50 in cash per key is required. Teams must sign their key back in by **10:00 on Friday, February 6th, at the latest**.

Lost or unreturned keys will result in a charge of €50 per key. The deposit will be refunded once the team cabin has been inspected and left in the same condition as when it was issued. If the team cabin sustains any damage, the deposit will not be refunded, and additional repair costs may be incurred.

A replacement key is available from the Team Cabin Coordinator if a key is lost. Teams are responsible for replacing lost keys, which is €50 per key.

3.8. TEAM BOXES (infield)

Infield boxes will be available from **Thursday, 29 January**. The Velodrome will be open from **09:00 until 19:00**. Team boxes are allocated in the infield, considering the size of each team. Due to the large number of people in the track center, the space is limited, and we ask you to keep to your allocated area.

Fire Regulations insist that corridors in the track are maintained for emergency evacuation purposes. To ensure the track center can be cleared quickly and safely in an emergency, please ensure that equipment does not excessively narrow or block walkways. Team boxes will have one table and chairs. No furniture is to be removed from the allocated box or chained up.

Power supply in team boxes

Teams boxes will be powered with 220V, standard 2-pin outlet. The venue requires that all electrical equipment meets standards to meet safety requirements. Teams must have all appliances tested and tagged by a qualified electrician. Please do not plug extension leads into this socket or kettles, coffee machines, or fan heaters, as they use high power consumption and may cause the supply to fail.

3.9. TEAMS CHANGING ROOMS

There are male and female changing rooms and shower facilities available at the ground level.

3.10. TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

There will be a reserved area for performance analysts on the back straight, equipped with platforms and power outlets only. Availability is limited to 15 spots and reservations will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. Booking is free of charge; however, teams wishing to reserve a spot must send an email to info@turkishcycling.com with the subject line "Performance Analysts".

4. MEDIA

4.1. MEDIA CENTRE

The Media Centre is located at the infield.

Media accreditation and photographers' bib's can be collected during the opening hours of the accreditation centre or at the media permanence. €50/CHF 50 will be requested for the bib as deposit. It will be refunded when the bib will be returned.

Please use "Track Booking" as the subject line and include the number of riders and the desired session details (date, duration, and preferred time slot between 10:00 and 19:00, in one-hour blocks such as 10:00–11:00 etc.). The LOC will arrange sessions based on requests and inform teams if a session will be shared with another nation. The rental price is 15 euros per rider per hour. Once a session is confirmed, an invoice will be issued, and payment will be required during the competitions, including in cases of no-show

6. EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

6.1. ARTICLE 1 - GENERAL RULES

- 1.1** The Union Européenne de Cyclisme in cooperation with the Turkish Cycling Federation will organise the 2026 Track Elite European Championships for the following disciplines.

These Championships may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team.

- 1.2** Registrations must be submitted by the National Federations as follows:

Registrations will be open on 2 January 2026, 12:00 CET

Registrations will be closing on 21 January 2026, 23:59 CET

Entrants for European Championships shall hold licenses issued by a Federation affiliated to the UEC and have the nationality of the Federation submitting the entry.

- 1.3** As the European Championships will be conducted in accordance with the UCI Regulations and format of the UCI World Championships, UCI article 9.2.022 is applied.

Team Managers may forward modifications to the Secretary of College of Commissaires until the start of the first competition session on the day of each event.

Therefore, National Federations may nominate the following riders / teams for the events:

Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit, qualification heats will run according to the competition schedule.

1.4 In accordance with the UCI, the participation in the competitions shall be open to riders of the following categories: second-year junior, U23 and elite.

1.5 The riders to contest each Championship shall be confirmed by an official of their Federation, to the Commissaires, during the confirmation procedure, before the start of the Team Managers meeting.

1.6 Riders age shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules.

1.7 Body numbers – Clothes

The riders are obliged to use the body numbers which will be supplied by the organization. Body numbers may not be folded or altered.

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

Riders shall wear one (1) body number in the following events:

1km TT, Individual Pursuit, Team Pursuit (each rider one number), Team Sprint (each rider one number).

Riders shall wear two (2) body numbers in all other races, Omnium included.

Riders competing in Madison will receive dedicated body numbers.

Pin less number systems

- Bunch events : numbers must be placed on outer layer of clothing
- Individual Pursuit / TT Km / Team Pursuit / Team Sprint : number pockets permitted

1.8 Publication

All results, rankings and communiqués will be available in teams announcement boards. Results will also be published on the UEC website: www.uec.ch and on the official live timing website: www.tissottiming.com

1.9 Unforeseen

In those events in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the UEC Technical Delegate and the organization (where applicable), will decide.

1.10 As per UCI regulation 1.3.023, any rider of height 1.80m and taller, who wishes to apply for height exemption for handlebar extensions, must submit a "Rider Attestation Application" form to the UCI 15 days prior the competition, so as to appear on the "UCI Official List of Riders in Category 2 & 3 Height" document. No rider height measurements will be performed at the championships.

6.2. ARTICLE 2 - EVENTS REGULATIONS

2.1. Sprint, Individual Pursuit, 1km and Time Trials, Points Races, Keirin, Scratch, Team Pursuit, Team Sprint, Omnium, Madison.

All the above-mentioned Championships will be conducted in accordance with the UCI Regulations and format of the UCI World Championships.

2.2 The seeding for all the above-mentioned championships will be done according to the UCI Regulations article 3.2.021 bis. The current UCI World Champions and the former UEC European Champions of the discipline, can be seeded in the first position.

2.3 Elimination race (as a Championship)

For the start of the race, riders shall line-up in single file along the railing and in the sprinters lane. The coaches holding their rider in the sprinters lane are allowed to push them during the start but from a standstill position (2 feet on the ground at the same time).

The order of the riders shall be determined according to the UCI regulations, in respect to their current UCI Individual Track Endurance Classification

The order for non-ranked riders, will be done by drawing lots by the PCP.

Team managers are reminded to collect their LED devices next to the race secretariat/timing platform, at least 30 min. before each Elimination race.

6.3. ARTICLE 3 - AWARDS

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded for:

The 1st place: Champion(s) jersey and Gold medal

The 2nd place: Silver medal

The 3rd place: Bronze medal

For team pursuit and team sprint, medals and jerseys will be awarded to all riders of the three teams on the podium. To receive the medal/jersey, the rider must have participated in the competition.

Winners are obliged to be in time for the awards ceremony.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey and shall not wear a helmet, a cap, a headband or glasses until they leave the podium ceremony area.

6.4. ARTICLE 4 - ANTIDOPING

The event may be selected for doping controls either by the International Testing Agency (ITA). If selected, doping controls will be conducted under the UCI Anti-Doping Rules.

The antidoping tests will take place at the Antidoping Station, located on the ground floor in close proximity to the infield podium area.

6.5. ARTICLE 5 - PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

6.6. ARTICLE 6 – RESPONSABILITIES

The organizers and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organizers and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
